A fair increase in numbers and a new trainee at the helm. Simply put the best trade for a year with all accounts able to take cattle and active.

Top today in the Steers a proper small Butchers Steer from the Fountaine Family selling to 240p/kg with enough finish to befit its U grade body the same beast returning £1320. R grade Steers over 200p/kg topping at 210p/kg for Blues from Messrs Tivey, with A Sabin selling strong O +4 Blues to 195.5p/kg and Lims a touch leaner to 187p/kg. Angus lightweights to 194p/kg from Messrs Tivey.

Heifers a nice show and Butcher Wholesalers animated in a need to stock up, with many more needed to fill them. Shape and finish from Messrs Fountaine saw Heifers to £1409 at 572kg or 246.5p/kg. Strong R Grade meat to 224p/kg from the same home with proper finish travelling the deadweight price past comparison as Butchers reward meat and finish. Heifers today well finished and most on the cusp of R and O+ grades and regularly selling to the 210p/kg mark with R S Beaty & Sons selling to 211p/kg and R J Wrights 18month old Angus Heifer 210.5p/kg and £1211.

Trade simply put looking as strong as I have seen.

#### Cows

Sadly only a few. If anything dearer than the clean, U grade with shape at 116 months from JB HM & J Gilbert taking 180.5p/kg at 747kg returning £1349. Others from the same wonderful home to 158.5p/kg at 721kg whilst genuine meat Cows to 135.5p/kg from Messrs Tivey. Even Dairy wet bags to 116p/kg today from Messrs Mann, Stratford Upon Avon returning £900.

#### Bulls

Only dairy breds but two new accounts available today and sadly only a few to go at. Best Bulls in demand and sold without age limit easily. Simmentals today for Bucket Bulls at 194p/kg from Alan Tacy whilst a close to age Angus Bull took weight to pay the Bills returning £1345 from W S Harrison & Sons, Daventry.

## SHEEP: 3737 FORWARD PRIME HOGGS: 2660 FORWARD SQQ 272P/KG

Every Hogg in return an Avg £114 with new Accounts and Buyers at ringside.

A massive rise in numbers today to just short of 2700 Hoggs with sheep travelling from Wiltshire, Bristol, Norfolk and Lincolnshire plus all the usual catchment points. In truth Vendors picking the day to show. An SQQ of 272p/kg not telling the complete story with the yarding in general lacking the quality we are used too, with a lot of clear up jobs and marginal breeds on show. In short today trade based solely on a need for meat and numbers. If we had put together a varding of the quality sometimes on Parade who knows the SOO could have pushed 290p/ kg!!!!. As it stands an SQQ of 272p/kg equal to 585p/kgdw. Top of the tree today some of the only genuine shape penned with real lambs from Passmore & Nunnerley seeing 38.5kg to 330p/ kg selling to Germany and 37kg Beltex from the same to 330p/kg for the Home trade. OJ & MJ Guest showed shape to see 38kg to at 313p/kg and little plums to 311p/kg at 35kg. H Collins & Son, Northampton took 310p/kg with C Mcmillan, Cheshire 36.5kg to 310p/kg. Some of the only real Export lambs on show from K Crabtree 43kg to 307p/kg. Messrs Avery, Woodward, Elkington, Hopcraft and Marsh Hill Farm Ltd all breaking the 300p/kg mark. In the heavies meat is always key. Top for the section 46kg to 283p/kg from J B Elkington whilst equal weight from R Woodward saw 280p/kg and again 278p/kg from K Crabtree. The Cotswolds head shepherd D G Coombes saw his run of 180 top at 46kg 274p/kg. In the lump J B Elkington saw Euro weights top at £132.50 at 45.5kg with 43kg and 44kg to £132 from Messrs Crabtree. 38.5kg to £127 from Passmore & Nunnerley. Weight starting to really pay again with Messrs Cook from Bristol travelling up with 172 lambs to see a ticket with an avg of £139 for 62kg. Top today though to Local Dairy farmers JT Jeyes & Son selling 64kg to £151. Messrs Cook then £144 at 57kg, £142 -67.5kg then 6 pens in a row at £141!!!

Trade merely a response to National shortage of Supply and will be dictated by Supplies going forward and a weakening  $\pounds$  likely to assist Producers. Interestingly though it seems the 40% Tariff talked of throughout 2020 has been witnessed, but who thought it was to be directed via the Live ring to Farmers pockets.
