An increased entry of mixed quality was offered to a full ring of buyers and wholesalers with extra orders at ringside. Commercial cattle would be 5p dearer on the week while the butchers Heifers were 2p dearer on the week.

Weight everywhere in the entry and several super-heavy, Charolais bulls sold to £1492.02 from Lester Smith. A marvellous load of heavyweight Simmentals sold to £1464.81 and averaged £1416.43 from Messrs Evans, Abbey Farm.

PRIME LAMBS: 2720 Forward SQQ 194p/kg

HENRY JAMES REIGNS SUPREME IN HIS FIRST YEAR

All out in force today with the best part of 2700 lambs in the aisles. A yarding of two halves. Some very good meat and others that should have been saved for another day. Ram lambs are only in demand if meated and very lean lambs presented forward have very little audience. Meated lambs in great demand and easy to sell today topping at 231p/kg for 44kg Texel from Flock Master Henry James, whom showed his first ever lambs today, already showing he knows the difference between fit lambs and lean lambs. Stuart Wise, good grading 40kg Texels took 225p/kg. M Morris, Padbury showed smart meat with weight to 45.5kg at 223p/kg and IM Allen & Partners, Lutterworth 218 and 216p/kg at 38.5 and 40kg for Beltex. Today 320 lambs passing under the hammer at over 200p/kg. In the heavies a top of 212p/kg from S & J Farming at 49kg with Charollais properly fed. Stone House Farming 48kg to 207p/kg and 46kg to 205p/kg. In the lump meated Euro weight lambs sold to £101.50 for 45.5kg from M Morris, Buckingham with Henry James 44kg to £101.50. Stone House Farming 45.5kg to £93. Overall a top today of £115 for 77kg from FJ Tombs & Son with DP & DM Hopcraft 59kg to £111 and BMF Smith 54.5kg to £109.50. Meat wanted and if not for the oddities and very lean end of the sheep today an SQQ of 200p/kg would have been seen. Trade a response to the coming Eid festival. The concern moving forward is the sudden uplift in numbers nationally. This should be monitored, and lambs only drawn when fit.
