Numbers slightly disappointing after the excellent trade experienced over the past month. Buyers were forward in good numbers, with all the butchers present and trade a lot sharper on the week in particular the commercials.

#### BULLS: 3 HEAD

A small entry of Holsteins, all from Geoff Ratcliffe were well received at ringside selling to 134p and 133p. Top price per head was £864.30 from Elms Farm.

#### STEERS: 5 HEAD

Shortage of numbers met a fast selling trade with all weights and breeds in demand. Topping the section was a superb heavyweight Limousin from Steve Webster's wagonload of cattle which made 204p. A superb heavyweight blue from Steve realised £1539.00, as ever more are needed to supply the growing demand at ringside.

#### HEIFERS: 25 HEAD

Trade simply on fire with bids coming from all corners of the ring. Commercial types were in tremendous demand, up 3-6p on the week and more are needed to supply demand. The Trivett family brought their usual quality and topped the sale at 228p with a superb butchers heifer. Simon Darker sold Lim's to 207p with the Timbs family, from Oxford load of Simmental's selling to 205p. and averaged 200p. Top price was £1342.92 for the aforementioned Limousin, with others to £1317.26 from High House Farm.

#### CALVES: 101 Forward (All under 42 days)

Breaking the three figure barrier today as the calf section moves from strength to strength. I would like to thank everyone for their respective help in the calf section today, buyers, vendors and volunteer staff alike. Topping the calves today was a super Charolais x bull calf from GE Pountney selling to £330 at 3 weeks, with a sister to £200. A desperate shortage of continental calves today saw other strength to £260 for Limousin x from PC Cox at 4 weeks, and smaller rearing sorts to £140 from the same home. The majority of the entry today comprising of natives. Strong Angus x Bull calves to £280 from Mark Bailey, Biddulph Moor with sisters to £185. Rearing Angus calves trading around the £100 with smaller, harder done sorts £50-£60. No end of Hereford x Calves forward today with a super entry from Whetstone Pastures Dairy, selling Bulls to £280 on 2 occasions and Heifers to £190 on 5 occasions. Rearing Herefords trading around the £150 mark for Bulls, with Heifers £110-£140, with bright but small Hereford x Bulls around the £70 mark. Only a few Black and whites forward today topping at £52 from Border Holdings.

#### Spring Lambs: 860 Forward SQQ 256p/kg

Numbers now coming forward and abattoirs seemingly now starting to switch albeit almost exclusively buyers being exporters or high end Butchers. Still no purchase power from Supermarket suppliers for the Spring lambs today. An SQQ of 256p/kg an increased trade on the week but in truth representing more than this with a lot of heavy end lambs weighing 43 to 45kg in the SQQ and also marked number of poorer lambs forward today. 36kg to 40kg lambs much dearer today with real demand. In the Spec Lambs a top ppk of 282p/kg for Beltex from T H Morris at 38kg with R Hicks, Hellidon 38kg Beltex 282p/kg R Griffin, Warmington whilst Cotswold farmers S D Harrison & Sons Ltd travelled over to take 282p/kg at 37kg. In the heavies a harder trade solely due to a lack of National demand for heavy bodies. Top though dominated by MM Clarke & Sons with good meat throughout seeing 45kg 242p/kg, 241p/kg and 240p/kg. In the lump Spec Lambs topping at £111.50 from Smith and Baxter, Sheepy Magna with real shape Charollais at 41kg. D Dashwood 42kg to £109.50 and T H Morris & Sons £109 for 38kg. Heavies saw 50kg to £110 from MM Clarke & Sons whilst R J Osborn & Son £110 for 48kg. Today 699 Lambs selling over the £100 mark.

Bucket reared Calves from H Hurst & Son, Stratford upon Avon saw £770 for a pen full of Angus 15 month old with sisters £725. Strength of an Nightingale bred Angus Steer from A Wilkin, Stratford Upon Avon at 11 month saw bidding top at £930. Then into a consignment of smart bred sorts from A North & Sons that set off with the youngest at 14 months of age seeing Limousin Steers £1130 x 3, £1105 and £1100 with sisters £1110 x 2 and £1105 with others of either sex £1020 to £1010. Messrs Baylis Partners showed youth to see Limousin x Steers to £900 for 14 months x 5 with Blondes £810. Stronger Stores in greatest demand with Messrs Bywater selling Bucket Blue Steers at £1040 16 – 18 months and Angus £970. 21 to 22 month old Steers from Townsend Farm, Cherington saw £1100, £1075 and £1040 for Steers. Neighbour Messrs Everett, saw £1100 at 23 months for Charolais with Angus £1000 and Blue Heifers £1010 all done on a bucket. 
