Up and above the 1000 lambs mark for the first time in the season. A yard of real quality in farming but absolutely no superstars on display. Some lambs though should be noted as being rushed to kill a little too early. An SQQ of 316p/kg though very much a reflection of the trade with two brand new accounts buying here today. The Sqq perhaps would be a further 5p/kg dearer if it was not for the amount of weight on show with over half the Spec entry weighing over 43kg. In the Euro Spec lambs a top today of 338p/kg for 40.5kg from MJ Harris Farming ahead of Texels at 38kg to 334p/kg from T H Morris & Sons with FI & EJ Barnes 38 and 39kg to 334p/kg and SF & AJ Deeming 333p/kg for 38 and 39kg. In the heavies a top of 311p/kg at 46kg split between both MJ Harris Farming and MM Clarke & Sons. In the lump a top of Euro Spec at £144 for 45kg from SF & AJ Deeming. R & T Reeve sold 44kg to £140 and R F Leach 45kg to £140. Overall a top of £158 for C W Thomas at 60kg and 55kg to £155. Heavy weights hardest to sell and vendors perhaps reminded lambs best shown at 38 to 42kg at this time of the year. Competition throughout though and all guns blazing.

This Grafton Horatio Sired Heifer stretches back to the ET Cow LS Special K and sold with favourable figures of +52 for 600 day weight and +23 for Self Replacement Index to G Price, Llangadog. Commercial customers looking for recip heifers or to bolster Commercial Herds helped to make for a competitive trade with the Maidens averaging 1090gns. Quality this year perhaps the worst on show thus far for this fixture. The promise though of a variety of customers from either side of the Pedigree hedge made for a fair trade with quality dealt with accordingly.
