

Bulls-12

Plenty of weight forward in the Bulls today, with demand slightly off the boil as reports of plentiful Bull supplies in the north. Top PPK to PM Wilks selling Limousins to 193PPK to AJ Green & Sons, Stoke on Trent with a top gross to CH Evans & Son selling Simmentals to £1298 to Mutchmeats, Witney. Handier weight Bulls seeing more competition, with those over 700KG limiting their customer base.

Steers-20

A mixed show of Steers forward, with some nicely fed, more traditional types about today, as well as leaner, more extreme continentals. Top PPK today for properly fed Bullocks from Frank Hodgkin seeing 205PPK with the same beast grossing £1336 selling to Witney. Meat rewarded in all shapes today with "O" grading Dairy bred Hereford x Steers seeing 190PPK from Chris and Rob Barnett.

Heifers-29

A fantastic show of Heifers forward today, with butchers types really ringing the bell. Top PPK to RW & HER Trivett selling Limousin x to 244PPK to local butcher P Reid, with ringman Pete Jarrom close behind at 242PPK. In the lump the Trivetts on top again selling stablemates to £1480. Natives too seeing a flier Beef Shorthorns from young Charlie Jarrom, selling his first fat beast to 200PPK to Joseph Morris Butchers, Lutterworth.

SPRING LAMBS: 2232 FORWARD SQQ 210P/KG

Frankly a very hard days trading. Rows of buyers and returning accounts from North of the Border but simply put, the Abbatoirs seemingly cant sell Lamb meat in the quantities being shown across the Country. History shows there is a 10-14 day period each June when a slump occurs and the Deadweights close intake. This will be no different this year and will even out as Vendors begin to wean and early bloom lightweight lambs disappear. Today a varding of two halves with some very smart Beltex at the top end but over a third of the yarding O and O- 4 grade Lambs that seem to be those earliest born and having suffered early weather badly. Export weight lambs very well contested. Top today 280p/kg for Beltex at 37.5kg from S Collie who also sold to 275p/kg at 40kg. 42.5kg from new Customer P Roma saw 259p/kg and 40kg at 250p/kg. Dabba Mitchell keeping the end up for the locals with 41kg to 249p/kg ahead of Ross on Wye Travellor C Price at 249p/kg. Heavies not such a fancy show today but selling to 46kg from BF Humphrey & Sons, Winslow at 226p/kg with David Ofield 46kg to 217p/kg and RDG Taylor 52kg at 212p/kg. Lambs in the lump not guite so impressive now but still into £110 for 40kg from S Collie and equal money for 42.5kg. £102 from Dabba Mitchell at 41kg. Heavies a harder trade but not as hard hit as the Export Lambs with 52kg to £110 from RDG Taylor and £110 x 2 pens from FJ Tombs & Son at 54kg. Martin Morris, Stoke Golding £106 at 52kg. Trade hard work start to finish. Buyers all around but no orders !!
