Cattle:

New faces throughout and trade that was quite astounding. Factory cattle almost exclusively with very few better than R grade but today fed cattle well appreciated. Buyers in force and all grades catered for.

Steers:

No show stoppers at all today but genuine meat throughout to see an all in Steer avg of pennies short of £1600!!!

Top today a medium weight Steer from G Burchell & Sons travelling up from Piddington for U-to 271p/kg whilst proper fed sorts from Padray Farms, Rushden took 270.5p/kg with R Grade Charolais and Salers from Hull Farms saw weight at 247p/kg, 246p/kg, 244p/kg x2 etc etc. O+ grades today hitting past 240p/kg where they had enough feeding to show past a 3H. In the lump a top of £1860 to Messrs Burchell with Hull Farms £1803 and B Cummings £1802. Trade simply bolistic and heart- warming to witness.

Heifers:

Again meat for days but short on confirmation. Top today D, NJ & HJ Parrott, Cherington selling Simmentals to 266p/kg ahead of Parry Walters at 265p/kg and Padray Farms 257p/kg. R Grades all exclusively over 250p/kg with Messrs Emery, Peebles and Gibson over this rate. Top gross £1717 to Martin Emery and £1711 to Messrs Parrott purchased by Joseph Morris Butchers Ltd.

Bulls;

A super little Charolais Bull at 20 months from T Gaden, Stow on the Wold returning 262p/kg and £1525 selling to Ralph Pearson Wholesalers, Bradford whilst O- Grades to 212p/kg from A Tacy.

OTM:

Trade as hot as any other part seeing 222p/kg and £1692 from G Allen, Hethe for Heifer having reared a calf.

Cows:

Super Cow trade today with meat well chased and the only commodity hard to cash being grazing Cows. Top today 196p/kg for R Heckford with young Cows whilst older sorts at 44m from Parry Walters seeing 190p/kg and proper aged Cows to 187/kg from Thomas Gaden. Plenty of heavy meat over 167p/kg and 178.5p/kg for Messrs Windridge. In the lump a top of £1475 for Messrs Windridge with £1323 to Thomas Gaden. Trade simply wonderful and Cows paying to feed not just cash.

The January Blues hang over the Hogg trade akin to the fog across the Midlands on Monday. Short weeks at local Abbatoirs and a buying audience cut in half a sign of how hard the trade is selling lamb this month. Despite this RFM returned to top of the leader board posting an SQQ of 283p/kg well ahead of deadweight comparison for a smaller yarding of Sheep and avg £123 for the entire yarding. Trade today boosted by mainstay Customers increased City demand and a much improved quality of fed lambs today over last weeks offering. City and best end lambs well chased throughout. City lambs to 356p/kg from Stephen Leedham and Beltex 352p/kg from Dabba. J Cope travelled from Aylesbury at 325 and 324p/kg. Dabba 38kg to 313p/kg and M J Woodward 37.5kg at 312p/kg. 45kg to 309p/kg from B Burton and 40.5kg to 307p/kg from S Leedham. Heavies a decreased demand with home sales falling as Christmas Credit comes home to roost. Meat though wanted and 47.5kg to 301p/kg from B Burton with 47kg 297p/kg from J B Elkington who also sold 46kg at 282p/kg with Robert Nichols 46kg 278p/kg. In the lump hard not to be happy if you compare year on year as opposed to having short term memory only. Export weights to £139 at 45kg from B C Burton whilst K Crabtree saw 45kg at £131 and J Elkington £130.50. Heavies topping at £143 for 47.5kg from B C Burton whilst W Gaydon 60kg to £143 and W G Moore £141.50 at 52kg. D G Coombes £141 with Coombes Elkington and J & S White making £140.

Trade struggling at the other end and Buyers seeing fit to not even come to buy as it stands with Sales at record lows. Supply side slows will help for demand to return hopefully before purchase price has to fall too far to propagate demand.
