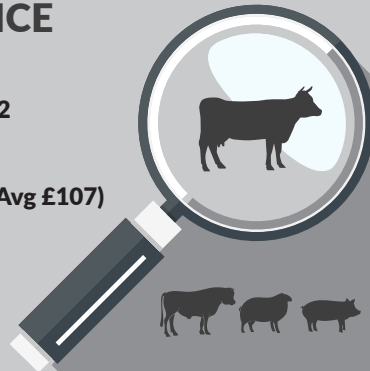

Perhaps the hardest day to call for an Auctioneer with the sale falling the day before Eid Al Ahda. This year Lambs not strictly allowed for submission as Quarbani offerings and therefore merely only seeing an advantage from the festival as Muslim households have a week of Festive eating. The countries biggest yarding for the day at a pen short of 3000 Lambs today meeting an Sqq of 258p/kg a number discounted by a large number of light lambs which always suffer at Quarbani time. A major concern is that we had only 700 Lambs booked in prior to the sale and indeed we budgeted for 2000 with the buyers. That said 3000 lambs presented to a faithful row of Buyers. Exporters racing to catch the last boats prior to the Festival and trade very much rewarding best finished sorts. In the Exports a top of 291p/kg at 43kg for Beltex from R J Heckford. E Brain & Sons Ltd, Stratford Upon Avon 40.5kg to 286p/kg, IM Allen & Partners, Lutterworth 39kg to 285p/kg and W Pearson & Son 41kg to 280p/kg. Heavies well chased and meat very much rewarded with Exporters taking added weight seeing a top of 266p/kg at 47kg from MC & MI Herbert, Brackley equal with R Gregory, Fenny Compton. Humphrey Livestock 46kg to 263p/kg. Export weights still totting up and seeing a top of £125 for 43kg from R Heckford OBE with Humphrey Livestock 43kg to £120, IM Allen & Partners 43kg at £120 and the same for Humphrey Livestock and R & S Farming down from Rutland. In the lump Lambs topping at £140 for 56kg from B F Humphrey & Sons with J S Arthers 62kg to £140. J & S White Farms Ltd saw 54kg to £137 and FJ Tombs & Son 53kg to £135. Lamb trade now will have to find its new course after the Festival and ALL VENDORS SHOULD SPEAK WITH THE AUCTIONEERS BEFORE SELLING SHEEP NEXT WEEK. The result a short number of Buyers at ringside but a trade to match any we have seen recently for all grades other than the very lean and the best end both of which would be back on the week. Top today JS Arthers seeing £146.50 for Charollais Rams with a heavy Charollais Ewe from J E Smith £145.50 and others from Arthers £145. White Faces topping at £143 from C & A Morley with Suffolks from E J Taylor & Son to £142.50. Most weighted Ewes today well over £135. Suffolks £130 mark and Mules receiving the trade of the day to top out at £133.50 from WH & R Weston with R Wright £131 and Burman Bros £130. Next week Ewe trade will want monitoring. Likely Ewes will be needed but fat Ewes will certainly see a much decreased audience.

15TH JULY STORE CATTLE



Into the middle of July on a scorching hot day and many of our farmers having grass down....you would think a recipe for not many farmers or buyers but to the contrary a packed ringside of buyers wanting cattle as beef prices remain strong.

Messrs G Hall & Son started the sale with a 3rd Calver Simmental Cow with her 4mo British Blue Calf at foot and also 2 1/2 months in calf to a top 10% Limousin Bull and was sold to Richard Ellis. The outfit realised £1950.

A few young cattle followed, J O Smith, Lapworth selling Limousins £770 - £800 and Messrs PE & KJ Dickin, Knowle Herefords £635 - £660.

Then came a consignment of reared cattle from A M Dowler of Ilmington, just becoming clear of TB restrictions and selling 11/12 mo Holstein Steers £390 - £600, 12mo British Blue Steers to £800 and Heifers to £680, 11mo Angus Steers to £795 and Heifers to £400.

More reared Calves from AM Dowler are expected in our next calf sale on Monday 26th July.

Today we had a very good consignment of Charolais cattle from Messrs EC Parker & Son, Tysoe with his 23mo Steers at £1350 and 12/16mo Steers £1050 - £1315 and 13/15 mo Heifers £1090 - £1350 and an odd 15mo Angus Steer at £1225.

Other highlights included Messrs DA & J Jackson, Cadeby making the right decision to sell through the ring and was handsomely rewarded and being pounds better off went home extremely happy. He sold a 2yo Limousin Heifer at £1450 along with a 20mo British Blue Steer at £1460, other Blue Steers 18/20 mo £1120 - £1210.

The sale concluded with cattle from Messrs G & W Plant, Morton Bagot, selling 25mo Hereford Steers £1045 - £1060 and a Heifer to £1040. Also his strong Longhorn Steer to £960.
