#### SPRING LAMBS: 3463 FORWARD SQQ 221P/KG

Another big show of lambs with 3463 penned for the usual set of end user Customers to battle over. Trade slightly more tentative with large numbers out Nationally but an SQQ of 221p/kg without compare on the dead and also a very good return for a yarding lacking in class this week with many grass lambs coming to the trade and a wealth of lambs marketed at 38kg that would be best marketed at 42 to 44kg. Thankfully the current unprecedented Season for selling lambs continues with lambs all in averging £95 per head. In the Euro weights a top ppk today of 267p/kg from R Richins, Oxford with Beltex at 45kg ahead of loyal supporters AEJ & FJ Claridge, Buckingham with a pen full of 41kg to 262p/kg and Famington Farms a small but perfectly formed plum at 31kg to 261p/kg. Chiltern Beltex showed meat to 260p/kg with Messrs Claridge again 259p/kg at 41kg whilst tiny bodies full of meat saw a pen of 14 take 252p/kg from Messrs Sparey, Herefordshire. Weighted meat wanted and well contested for throughout with finish definitely rewarded this year. Top for Mr Heady, Denton selling 47kg to 245p/kg and others 236p/kg with Humphrey Livestock 50kg to 234p/kg and Culworth Grounds, Banbury 46kg to 230p/kg. In the lump Export lambs still an unprecedented figure. Top £120 at 45kg from R Richins, Oxford with Beltex whilst Messrs Claridge 45kg to £108.50, 41kg £107.50 and £106. S M Ellingworth, Market Harbrough 42kg to £100. Goats from Messrs Wilson, Southend on Sea saw 40kg to £100. Heavies wanted and topping at £117.50 at 48kg from A Tarry-Smith with 50kg from Humphrey Livestock £117 and Ted Taylor £116 and £115.50. Trade now needs monitoring as Supply levels for the Festival have never been so hight in previous years.

A record number of Ewes forward seeing 1933 Ewes pass through the ring and pens. Numbers handled throughout with a strong trade throughout with only grazing Ewes and Mules back on the week and strong Ewes remaining swift. Top today saw Texel Ewes to £137 from IM Braund, Holsworthy, Devon with others £129 from Hatherleigh, Devon. Chiltern Beltex saw a pen of Ewes to £118. Top Ram for the day from Vicarage Farm (quinton) Ltd to £116 for Texels equal with Charollais Rams from Upper Lea Farms. Strong Ewes regularly over £100 with Texels a little thick to £115 for Greenfields of Twycross. Charollais Ewes from John Peebles, Shipston on Stour to £114. Zwartble Rams to £109.50. Top Suffolks to IM Braund at £105 with most weighted ewes selling £101 to £90 with most in the £100 region if weighted. Top Mules today to £93 for strong Mules from PD & C Davenport, Banbury and Romneys to £92 from N G Adams, Chipping Norton. Mules generally £80 to £83 whilst many with weight in excess. Half Meated Ewes regularly in the £70 mark and meated Welsh and Scot Black Face Ewes to £64. Trade likely to now steady as the Festival approaches.
