All good things come to an end and the dizzy heights of the lamb trade coming back sharply today albeit trade much better than that expected if anyone referenced the current Deadweight demand. An Sqq of 228p/kg ahead of expectations and representing just under £5kgdw well ahead of alternatives. Trade sticky and simply a matter of a lack of demand on the Continent. Top today 268p/kg for 41kg from R Richins, Oxford with G R Fountaine 43kg to 262p/kg and PD & DM Hopcraft 259p/kg. Heavies an easier sell for Home trade and seeing a top of 255p/kg for 51kg for V R Phipps, Banbury. Ben Burton with quality throughout and seeing 46kg to 248p/kg whilst PD & DM Hopcraft 47kg to 247p/kg. Despite the slow in trade a yard avg of £102 equal to a requirement of an overall avg of 21.3kg carcass weight on current Deadweight quotes. Top Export gross today saw £112.50 for 43kg from GR Fountaine & Son whilst £110 saw 41kg from R Richins, Oxford with £109.50 and £109 from JB Elkington & E Brain & Son. Overall a top today from D W Gurney & Son to £133 and £132 x2 at 59 to 66kg whilst V R Phipps took £130 and H L Goode & Son £125.50. A hard trade but hopefully a swift steady along with more Autumnal weather may encourage orders from Europe in the coming weeks.

These Maiden Angus Heifers 15 -16 months of age met a swift enquiry from Commercial Herds to top at 1100gns and see the majority trade 1000 to 1070gns.

The highest number in this yarding for some years with most Vendors having TB Tests booked for October, met a trade that dealt with quality as appropriate. Some very hard done young stock looking low in figures but as dear as they have been in fact, with recent years having proven Buyers to need "sure bets" before facing the dreaded grader. Smart youth from the Goodrest Herd of Poll Limousin saw £1130 at 12 months for Steers with 10 - 12 months £1100 and Heifers £1080. Dairy bred Angus from R & R Knowles saw 16 month Steers to £1045 with sisters 14-16 months £1000. P & F Baker returned to Rugby to see a smart trade for their goods with £1140 for Simmental Steers at 19 months and 14 months £1070. Charlie the Loong Horn took £900 at 15 months for Steph Powell with 18 month Holsteins to £600. TH Smith & Sons, Bumblebee saw £1145 for Herefords 17-18 Months for Heifers. Super Holstein Heifer from the same at 14 months to £945 and Blue Heifers 19 months £900. D Brown topped out at £1005 at 22 month for South Devon Heifers. Next in a lovely consignment from W S Harrison & Sons seeing Steers to £1240 for Angus at 15 months with others £1230 and £1225 a pen of younger sorts £1160. R L Root Leicester using the M69 well to receive a super topping trade at £1500 for Charolais Steers at 19 months of age. Angus from the same took £1180. £1150 and £1075 for 15 -17 months and Heifers £1060. 63 summered Cattle from Leam Farming saw an avg of £1080. Topping at £1300 twice for Limousin Steers at 17 months the run saw Charolais at £1220 at 17 months. Angus at £1285 at 19 months and plenty in the £1100's and Heifers to £1035.
