Prime Lambs: 1389 Forward SQQ 178p/kg

A tailored entry with numbers held under the 1400 mark to suit demand in these times of uncertainty. Trade should be reported as good with an SQQ of 178p/kg the highest in the land for the day and despite a derth of quality on show. Heavy lambs much harder to sell and numbers seemingly having caught up with demand but export quality lambs heavily contested throughout to give an sqq with a deadweight comparison of 3.85p/kg without a grid to face. Best end lambs today dearer than they have been for some time seeing a top of 234p/kg at 38kg from Chris Price, Tysoe ahead of Dabba Mitchell at 233p/kg for 43kg with R Richins 231p/kg equal at 39kg equal with Dave Mitchell who also has 222p/kg at 36kg. Heavies harder to shift unless showing grade today selling to 186p/kg at 46kg from Michael Cheney, Countesthorpe with R Richins 185p/kg for the same. Alan Boffey saw 47kg at 181p/kg. In the lump Euro lambs with shape well rewarded topping out at £100 for 43kg from D Mitchell, Atherstone with B C Burton 45kg at £92 and R Richins, Oxford £90 at 39kg. In the lump heavies topped at £96 from Humphrey Livestock at 64kg with HM & JM Titterton 55kg to £92 and Mark Lambert 56kg to £91. Heavies a much trickier trade, a result of the number of lambs held back for the job this year as well as the fact that lambs have progressed quicker than in past years. School Holidays now begin and likely will also diminish trade for heavy cutting lambs. Todays trade though a reassuring lift from an Export basis.

CHRISTMAS SHOW RICH FRUIT CAKE

Oven Temperature: 300 F, 150 C, Gas 1-2

Ingredients:

12 oz/325 g Currants

4 1/2 oz/125 g Sultanas

4 1/2 oz/125 g Raisins

3 oz/75 g Glace Cherries

2 oz/50 g Candied Peel

A little lemon rind

7 1/2 oz/215 g Plain Flour

1/2 teasp Mixed Spice

1/2 teasp Cinnamon

6 oz/175 g Butter

6 oz/175 g Brown Sugar

3 Large Eggs

1 tablesp Brandy

- 1. Line an 8 inch round cake tin, using 2 thicknesses of greaseproof paper. Tie a double band of brown paper/newspaper around the outside.
- 2. Mix the currants, sultanas, raisins, cherries and peel.
- 3. Cream the butter, sugar and lemon rind until pale and fluffy.
- 4. Add the beaten eggs and the brandy, a little at a time, beating well after each addition.
- 5. Fold in the flour. Then fold in the fruit.
- 6. Put in to the prepared tin, spread evenly.
- 7. Place in the pre-heated oven on a layer of brown paper/newspaper, in the lower part of the oven. Cook for approximately 2 3/4 hours
- 8. When the cake is cooked, leave it to cool in the tin, and then turn out onto a wire rack.
- 9. Store by wrapping in greaseproof paper and place in an airtight tin.

When judging, the cake will have to be cut in half to see the distribution of the fruit etc. Inserting a skewer will only achieve the taste of the cake. The cake can still be covered in marzipan and icing ready for using at Xmas.


