SPRING LAMBS: 2232 FORWARD SQQ 227P/KG

Just under 2300 Lambs forward today with lambs in general showing much greater bloom than those of last week. Pleasing to see that the new sorting and delivery system we have implemented resulted in hardly any delays in delivery meaning most vendors could drop and leave immediately, this considering 1100 Ewes and 200 other sheep travelled through the same docks was a great success. Trade today can only be described as fast throughout with an SQQ of 227p/kg and many lambs over 43kg. We started with a full compliment of buyers with long distance Abbatoirs in the aisles for the commencement of the sale but two soon drifting away unable to bid within 20p of the days trade. Trade for best end lambs swift throughout with weight not an issue. Light lambs with shape in high demand for the home Asian trade today and very fast indeed. Top today 270p/kg for Beltex Superlight shape at 31.5kg from BJ & IS Wain. S Ellingworth, Market Harbrough saw 38kg to 264p/kg and Messrs Leadbeater 38.5kg at 260p/kg. Mark Lambert maintained his amazing run of success for the season seeing 41.5kg at 258p/ kg and RF & JA Nichols 39.5kg 256p/kg. Heavies very much sort after today if holding meat and finish to see a top of 46kg at 253p/kg from Robert and Jenny Nichols, whilst Pete Incley, Long Buckby 48kg to 240p/kg and 47.5kg at 238p/kg. Proper shape from S Ellingworth at 48kg to 238p/kg. In the lump Export lambs starting to hit three figures again and topping at £110 for 45.5kg from Humphrey Livestock with Greenfields of Twycross 43kg to £107.50 and Messrs Lambert 41.5kg at £107 with RF & J Nichols £106 42.5kg. Heavies a real trade today and a massive lift on the week, in line with the opening of Society and a greater demand in the central markets. Top overall today £126 for 55kg from Fordwall Farm Partnership, Duxford with others 54kg to £124.50. Messrs Tombs continuing the great supply of properly meated lambs with pens £119, £120 and £121 for 50.5kg to 55kg. Trade today a delight for all and completely unexpected when looking at the dismal returns on the deadweight system.
