Recent reviews of our cost and services have required we alter our commissions to 3%. We remain competitive with a Max top of £38 and min of £28 to ensure our customers are charged a rate appropriate.

#### **CALVES: 128 Forward**

Again a mixed entry of calves, but I would first like to thank our regular buyer support for maintaining their presence at ringside to ensure our normal levels of trade, during these uncertain times.

Best end continental bulls remaining in high demand with P Dyson selling British Blues to £355, and Limousins from HM & JM Titterton to £305.

Best continental heifers also in strong demand with Limousin x from GTA Hall & Son to £282.

Rearing continental bulls actively £150-£190 with rearing heifers seeing £120-£170 all day.

Strong native bulls to £260 for Angus x from Pete Hemmings. No best end native heifers forward though rearing sorts of bulls forward trading between £95 and £150. Rearing heifers between £75 and £130. Dairy bulls looking a nicer trade. Rearing sorts up to £71 for Friesians from Pilkington Farms. Stronger sorts £50-60, medium processing types £25-£35 and smalls £15-£20.

We aim to continue to carry on selling calves as normal in a fortnight, however due to the current pandemic, it is uncertain that we will. Please contact Martin with further questions.

### Prime Hoggs: 1500 Forward SQQ 201p/kg

A day of extreme difficulty with Abbatoirs making temporary stoppages relating to the Covid -19 lockdowns. Before writing any report my thanks to my Staff who attended Voluntarily yesterday despite the severe difficulties they faced and of course having elderly loved ones at home. A note to our buyers also who in the hardest of conditions provided us with the Nations highest Sqq for numbers sold on the day. They like all of us are coming to terms with the situation personally and professionally and the way the conducted themselves yesterday was exemplary. Just under 1500 sold today of the 2800 penned to an SQQ of 201p/kg. Exports hoggs to 241p/kg from S Wise with Texels, whilst most trading 190 to 205p/kg. Top export £97 for 40.5kg from Sam Collie. Heavies trading to a top of 209p/kg for 48kg from S Wise and to a top gross of £120 for 58kg Richard Goodman.

Trade simply a reaction to Panic buyers reaching capacity and uncertainty of the ability to export going into the future. We are working with Defra and farmers to keep supply lines to Abbatoirs open. At the time of writing we intend to run a Market on Thursday under DEFRA RULES which are outlined separately in this report. Also next Monday we intend to hold a sale FOR PRE-BOOKED Stock only and using Government guidelines of only being able to drop off Stock on the docks before vacating the property. Together we hope to assist all Customers through this National Crisis.

# THE LAA & DEFRA WANT US TO CONTINUE BUT NEW RULES APPLY

With immediate effect LAA members MUST implement a "drop and go" policy for vendors bringing stock to market for sale. Vendors:

Members must implement a "drop and go" policy for vendors.

This action is to prevent any sellers from entering the market. Vendors MUST be instructed to deliver their animals to the loading docks (remaining in their vehicles) whilst the market staff unload the vehicle and take the animals to their pens. The sale documentation MUST be collected by the auctioneers staff from the vendor's vehicle when they arrive at the unloading docks – Vendors MUST NOT take the paperwork to the market office themselves, or enter the market pennage area for any reason.

The LAA appreciates that this will create many challenges – no more so than developing a system by which the vendor can accept or reject the price offered at the time of sale.

Unfortunately, if we want to stay in business and protect everyone from the virus we need to find and implement solutions to these challenges.

#### **Buyers:**

The number of buyers MUST be restricted to allow Social Distancing (2 meters between each buyer). The number of buyers able to attend may be different between markets, depending upon the size and layout of your sale pens and/or sale rings, and will result in some markets being able to manage slightly more buyers than others.

Markets MUST keep a register of those that attend their sales – contact name, address and telephone number.

At the conclusion of the sale buyers MUST be asked to enter the sales office in a way that does not result in too many entering at any one time.

Buyers should be asked to sanitise on entry to the market and again on exit.
