Please remember that an animal must be fit for the intended journey, it should not be ill, injured or severley lame ie. must be full weight bearing.

These sheep are being rejected at abattoirs around the Country

#### STORE CATTLE: 77 FORWARD

Cattle short across the Country and this week a respectable entry put togetles with Test Cattle travelling from Roxburghshire in Scotland. A large crowd of Buyers today looking for Cattle and TB4 Cattle in particular saw a trade that was perhaps as fast as ever witnessed. We even had a minor Celebrity keen to purchase!!

Others saw £1500, £1470, £1450 and £1430 all 10-13m of age. Next another Northern vendor down from Otterburn saw Hill grazed Cattle well chased. Llmx Steers 13-15m to £1305 and £1290 with sisters to £1200. D M Leedham next with a hard muscled Lim next took a 15m Heifer to £1580 selling to R Ellis. Cotswolds calling next with Roger Coombes down from Burford to see massive interest for his Bucket reared Blues and Angus Heifers. The Blue Heifers 18m taking £1270 and Angus £1060.

AT Harrison Claybank Pigs next saw Simmentals 19m at £1370 and £1260. Next another Gloucestershire Farmer saw AD Lane with Steers at £1520 at 36m for South Devons with others £1470 at 24m. K Attfield finishing the Sale strongly selling Angus Steers 24m at £1530 and £1400 with others £1220.

# SPRING LAMBS: 1590 FORWARD SQQ 376P/KG AVG £215



1600 forwards to a trade that commenced well above expectations on a day when firms decided to stop killing due to lack of Sales. As the day wore on though lambs harder and harder to place with Accounts short of orders and chat of a sudden further drop in demand this week. An SQQ of 376p/kg miles ahead of expectations albeit at the halfway point of the Sale this figure would be above 380p/kg. Lean and Mule bred Lambs hardest to fix with Export Sales very poor. Best Export Lambs still nice to sell throughout. Best lambs to 447p/kg & 439p/kg at 38kg for P K Cobley with J & R Lowe 435p/kg at 40kg with A K Wilson Rouge 36kg at 431p/kg and SM & JM Lambert 39kg at 424p/kg. Best end lambs regularly over 410p/kg. Meat Export trading 375-390p/kg. Lean Export Lambs 360p/kg mark and buyers actively to buy at less. Best meat weight well traded seeing 47kg to 409p/kg for RJ Wright and 48kg at 400p/kg for DJ & ST Webb with Deacon 396p/kg. Weight trading almost exactly at an equal for weight as that of the lightweights with home demand better than export. Export weights still totting up to see 45kg at £190 and £181 for R Heckford. Messrs Lowe 43kg to £180 with MM Clarke & Sons 44kg £180. Overall a top today of £215 for Matt Morris with 56kg and Messrs Leadbeater 54kg at £203. R J Heckford £200 at 55kg.
