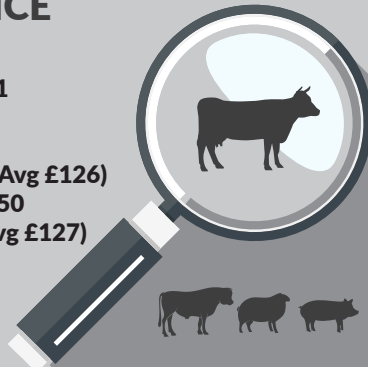

A day for the out of spec sorts with many O+ on show but those with meat easily handled to returns better than those dealt out by the graders.

Steers;

Top today a strong U- from DA & J Jackson, Market Bosworth at 240p/kg whom also sold heavyweight R Grades to 230p/kg. Handy weight meat R Grade from Pete Jarrom selling to 237.5p/kg ahead of good meat Angus O+ Steers from DJ Hull at 222.5p/kg. O+ to 215p/kg from the same. In the lump the leader board dominated by the Jackson family at £1661 and £1612. Handyweights from the same £1437 and £1410 from DJ Hull & Partners.

Heifers;

Not the show of quality we have seen but those at the top end of an R Grade to 233p/kg and 222p/kg for Parry Walters with O Grades all up towards 220p/kg. Top gross £1381 to Parry Walters.

Bulls;

A nice little show of Bulls and more wanted weekly. Top today a smart weighted U- Limousin from P M Wilks selling to 232p/kg and £1388. JHB Hart sold Blondes to 227p/kg.

SPRING LAMBS: 1203

FORWARD SQQ 327P/KG AVG £126

Less on parade than had been booked in due to the absolute deluge on Sunday with many producers reporting the lambs having been washed through over the weekend. Reports of dropping deadweight's and slow sales on the Continent did little for Confidence but an SQQ of 327p/kg for a yarding of lambs hit hard by the weather returns a deadweight equal at the very least of £6.74p/kg. Top today E Brain & Sons Ltd with real shape Texels at 40kg to 393p/kg ahead of a consortium of Mawby Grandchildren selling real Export lambs at 39kg to 383p/kg. AR & J Collett, Banbury sold real powerful Texels to 380p/kg at 38kg and Messrs Brain again 40.5kg at 370p/kg. In the heavies a stickier trade for the run of the mill but shaped Lambs seeming the easiest loaded onto the Boats. Smart meat from MM Clarke & Sons 46.5kg to 325p/kg and 49.5kg 324p/kg. Export Lambs still tot up very well. Top £157 for 40kg from E Brain & Son, Stratford Upon Avon before the RJM Consortium showed the Adults how it is done at £149.50 for 39kg and £149 for both 43 and 44kg. C R Hill 40kg to £147.50. Overall a top of £160.50 from MM Clarke & Sons at 49.5kg with others £152, £151, £151 and £151 from J Slee the same at 48 to 52kg. As it stands Lambs are trading at a price that is resisted by the European. The deciding point will be what happens when Hoggs are removed from the equation. Elasticity of demand to Lambs will then only properly be tested.
