A tailored entry to show caution to the sale date, placing it directly the day after the Eid of Ramadan and upon a National Bank Holiday. One pen short of 1400 Lambs forward and this could have been a thousand more if we had not held some back. Lambs therefore are certainly doing in the heat of early Summer. An SQQ of 246p/kg a marked decrease on the previous week but still in front of deadweight quotes for Monday morning and therefore a pleasing outcome to a days trading that saw a number of Pens that would kill very fat indeed. Quality though on show today and well rewarded throughout. Corwall last week and Norfolk this week in the top of the Pops with young Sam Collie, Norfolk very pleased with his business to see 270p/ kg for small Beltex but top of the tree this week at 282p/kg was Beltex from Rosie Leach at 34kg ahead of Leicester's Pete Cobley with peaches to 274p/ kg. 41.5kg from Rosie also 271p/kg whilst Mark Lambert took 38.5kg to 269p/kg. In the heavies some more quality about today with 46kg from S M Ellingworth, Market Harbrough to 248p/kg, S & J Farming saw 47kg to 245p/ kg and D Harris 48kg at 242p/kg. The Gross columns remain good reading with Messrs Ellingworth taking £114 at 44kg whilst Rosie Leach 41.5kg to £112.50. S Collie 43kg to £111, R Richins, Oxford 44kg to £110 equal with 41.5kg from E Brain & Sons Ltd and WJ Pearson & Son 43.5kg.In the heavies weight not quite the heights of last week as Hoggs remain out in numbers for heavies. Top today £119.50 for 53kg from FJ Tombs who also sold 52kg to £118. Hyde Lane Farming sold 55kg to £119. MM Clarke & Sons 53kg to £116. Trade basically governed by a large numbers of Springers and Hoggs to market Nationally and a slow after the Festival. Considering the absence of Catering Wholesalers across the land, trade though very acceptable.
