PRIME CATLE: 31 HEAD

A typical bank holiday market, with a short entry on offer to a full company of Butchers and Wholesalers at ringside with several extra faces present due to other Markets having the Bank Holiday off. The entry contained few if any showstoppers but the buyer strength at ringside saw all types dearer on the week with commercials 4-6p dearer on the week.

STEERS: 13 HEAD

An entry dominated by weight and dairy bred types met exceptional demand, and proved woefully short of buyers demands, regularly 192-196p. topping the section was a superb homebred Angus from Cedric Stiles which made 206p. Heavyweights sold to £1402.44 for a Saler X from Lester Smith who sold others to £1361.12. Dairy bred Blues sold to £1362.20 from Ratcliffe Farms Ltd who sold others to £1341.35.

HEIFERS: 11 HEAD

All the regular Butchers present, bidding on all the sweet heifers present without the usual showstoppers. Topping the section and sale was a pair of Limousin's which realised 210p, firstly from Simon Darker and secondly from Parry Walters, others sold to 206p. Heavyweights sold to £1288 from Manor Farm who sold others to £1213.34. As ever more are needed weekly to supply growing trade.

OTM's 7 HEAD

Demand outstripped supply, with buyers at all corners of the ring, topping the section was a heavyweight Limousin from Lester Smith, Radbrook Farm which realised 152p and grossed £1284.40. Angus sold to 136p from Mr. J. Peebles, who sold dairy Blue's at 114p. Clean Hereford heifers sold to 140p from Geoff and Sue, with travelled Herefords from St Albans realising 135p. A tremendous Blonde Stock Bull from Paul Edwards realised £1407.90.

A simply cracking show of calves, with trade soaring up to meet the numbers forward and fresh faces all around the ring. Native Calves dominating the entry, with Herefords a real trade. Strong Hereford x Bulls to £360 from Whetstone Pastures Dairy, with others to £350 from the same home, all under 42 days. Heifers to £310 for suckler bred sorts from Basil Page, Epwell. Rearing sorts from Pilkington Farms to £168, with others from Border Holdings to £160. No quality Angus Calves forward today but rearing sorts to £115 for Heifers from Evolution Farms with Beef Shorthorn x Heifers to £105 from the same home. Continentals the stars of the show, with Limousin x Bulls to £390 from MJ & R Titterton. Other bulls from the same home sold to £370. Heifers sold to £295 from the same stable. British Blues a good trade, with no Bulls forward, but Heifers to £310 from Phil Dyson, with others to £300 from RR Barrett & Son. The bottom end today looking some of the dearest with hard done, cold calves trading between £50 and £80. Reared Calves today looking a straight price. Top for a British Blue x 4 month Bull selling to £420 from Fences Farm LLP.

Buyers today travelling from Malmesbury, Loughborough, Leicester as well as the local faces. More calves are expected next sale with 30 already booked in. *Auctioneer: Martin Lloyd*

Spring Lambs: Forward SQQ 1436 235p/kg

More forward despite the Bank Holiday. Today only 400 booked in. How can we do our jobs Properly without knowing what is coming?

Trade lifted today despite the Bank Holiday and if it had not been for the large number of 43kg to 45.5kg Lambs in the averages we could have posted an SQQ past 240p/kg. Lambs over 41kg discounted and vendors encouraged to sell at 36 to 41kg to meet export trade. Todays SQQ at 235p/kg at 48% represents a deadweight equivalent of £5 without a grader, think about that geniuses. Export weight Hoggs strongly contested and selling to 268p/kg for 37kg from E Wells, Hunningham with properly bred and finished Texels, R Hicks showed similar quality to 266p/kg at 35.5kg and Mark Lamberts first day out 38kg to 263p/kg. In the heavies a top of 224p/kg at 47kg from Messrs Hopcraft with J & S White Farms Ltd selling 44.5kg at 219p/kg. In the lump an Export gross of £100 from SM & JM Lambert at 38kg with Messrs Ellingworth, Market Harbrough 41kg to £100 and R Richins, Oxford £99.50 at 42kg. Heavy lambs still not wanted as of yet with Hoggs preferred for the cutting and Supermarket jobs but grossing out at £105.50 for 47kg with R Richins 46kg to £99.50 and R Deacons, Leicester 47.5kg at £99.

Trade yet to level out but vendors urged to send us Export style Lambs and we will ensure that we supersede alternatives, please don't use us to Market what your favourite Factories simply wont.

Breeding Cattle Saturday 18th May

Saturday saw the annual Breeding Stock sale which this year included 38 Cow and Calf Units from two separate part farm dispersals plus 11 other units from locals farmers. Trade can only be quoted as hot with a pleasing selection of old and new buyers around a full ringside with buyers from Wales, Cheshire and the Eastern Counties. First through the ring was the Part Dispersal from P M Wilks, Towcester whom showed 13 Units to account for the loss of a part Tenancy. These Spring Calved Cows with Limousin Calves at foot were mainly first cross Blue Cows. The Consignment topped at £1525 for a 2014 Blue Cow with a March born heifer calf at foot selling to Hertfordshire. 2015 Blue Cows with February born heifer calves saw £1480 and £1420 whilst a older 2013 Cow again with a heifer calf at foot saw £1490. Regular Fat Cattle and Lamb vendor J B Baylis & Partners held similarly genuine Part dispersal to see real enquiry for Units best advertised by the Calves at foot. First Unit into the ring set the tone with a 2015 Pedigree Blonde Cow and February Steer calf sold to £1800 to Worcestershire. £1660 saw a 2012 Blonde Cow with Feb Calf sell locally to the Market whilst £1650 bought at 2015 Limousin x Cow with a November 2018 calf at foot, £1600 took a 2012 Blonde Unit and £1575 a Limousin unit.
