#### CATTLE: 135 Forward

#### PRIME CATTLE: 53 HEAD

A good entry for quality throughout the section's saw extra numbers easily accommodated when offered to a full company of buyers, with all the butchers back at ringside and looking for cattle. Taking quality into consideration, all classes would be dearer on the week and as ever more are required to meet the growing demand at ringside. Butcher types were in great demand and proved short of buyer's needs.

#### **BULLS: 2 HEAD**

A short entry consisting of solely of Herefords sold well to a top of 154p and grossed £1193.50 from D.P. Jones and as ever more could be easily sold.

#### STEERS: 13 HEAD

The entry had quality throughout with several runs of quality cattle forward, the section was topped by a superb heavyweight limousin from Mr. P. Steels, which realised 220p. Messrs Tivey sold Angus's to 211p with P.Steels making 211 p, again for a Lim. A dairy bred Blue from Messrs Trice made 201p. Heavyweight topped at £1454.20 from Gravel Farm, with others £1367.84 from Hill Farm. As trade continues to rise buyers are looking for all types and with the buyer strength at ringside the value of the auction system is there for all to see.

#### HEIFERS: 18 HEAD

Eighteen heifers forward, we could have sold 80!!!!

Buyers all around the ring, all types wanted and several orders not opened due to shortage of quality cattle. A superb trailer-load of cattle from Peter Wilks topped the section and sale at 221p and 220p for Lim's, others sold to 217p from Parry Walters. Messrs Lea sold big heifers to 215p, heavyweights realised £1330.21 from Parry Walters, with others to £1283.55 from Nigel Redfern.

#### OTM's and CAST COWS: 20 HEAD

An entry packed with weight and quality throughout, met excellent competition selling to 143p and averaging 121p overall. Richard and Lynn Smith showed a tremendous load of cows with meat everywhere and topped the sale with a Simmental at 143p, they sold others to 132p for Lim's. Angus's from Woods Farm realised 124p, with dairy bred Blue's to 121p from J.S. Agricultural Services. Heavyweights sold to £1064.96 from Hill Farm. As buyers are finding more demand for cows, numbers are needed to supply demand, let's not disappoint. Cast Bulls realised 113p, £1131.13 from J.S. Agricultural Services.

Top Angus today from Mark Bailey, Biddulph Moor seeing Bulls to £305 and Heifers to £260 all at 3 weeks. Phil Dyson showed his usual quality to see month old Limousin bulls to £325 and British Blue x brothers to £305. Whetstone Pastures Dairy showed 30 Hereford x calves today to average £212.67 for both bulls and heifers. Top Black and Whites today from Evolution Farming to £90.

#### Prime Hoggs: 2086 Forward SQQ 222p/kg

Numbers shorter than anticipated with over half of them in the market on Sunday night with Hoggs travelling from Sussex, Surrey, Monmouthshire and Essex. An SQQ of 222p/kg about the dearest in the country for a yarding that was not spectacular but did show a good run of export Hoggs to match the need of the Wholesalers. In the PPK this week a top of 278p/kg from V J Roots, Beltex with his other 42.5kg to 271p/kg and JFH Farming, East Sussex selling to 265p/kg for 39kg whilst O J Lee, Hailsham sold 37kg Texels to 259p/kg. In the heavies a top of 257p/kg for 47kg Beltex from Messrs Root. R C Hawes, Brackley selling smart Texel 47kg to 232p/kg and 231p/kg proper heavies 51.5kg to 222p/kg and Anthony Spencer, Lower Quinton 52.5kg at 219p/kg. In the lump Euro Hoggs topping out at £125 for 45kg from V J Roots Beltex whilst his 42.5kg to £115. JFH Farming's long journey rewarded at £104 for 44kg equal with 43.5kg from R C Hawes with 39kg to £103.50 from Sussex. Heavies now a static trade with our three heavy Hogg buyers unable to offer anywhere near the trade for export Hoggs and a standardised price for over 50kg now established at £96 despite weight, Simply supply exceeding demand. £121 for 47kg from Messrs Roots with 58kg £119. Anthony Spencer, Lower Quinton £115 for 52.5kg and Di Hopcraft £115 and £114.5 for 51.5 to 52kg. Heavies only holding a premium for shape with weighted meat sadly unwanted.
