Prime Lambs: 1366 Forward SQQ 181p/kg

A manufactured decreased number of lambs on parade to respond to current demand met an increased SQQ of 181p/kg buoyed by a number of best end lambs. A lot of lambs forward today from vendors usually using the local deadweight option but massively disillusioned. All lambs are welcome but lambs best sold through these gates a grade better finished than the local alternative. Euro spec lambs in best demand today selling to 244p/kg for 41kg from A Bishop, Tewkesbury with 235p/kg at 38.5kg and 221p/kg at 43kg ahead of John Elkington 37.5kg at 216p/kg. Heavies also dominated by Messrs Bishop Beltex selling to 235p/kg at 46kg whilst Culworth Grounds 47.5kg at 198p/kg followed by two pens in a row at 193p/kg.

In the lump handy weights selling to £100 at 43kg from A Bishop with 43kg to £95 whilst 45kg from Slapton Manor £91. Overall £108 for 46kg from Messrs Bishop at 46kg whilst 60kg from Messrs Claridge £105. Trade continues to be hard graft with some buyers set on such low purchase prices they decline from bidding to cause offence. We will start marking Ram lambs for Quarbani as of this Monday with lambs born on the 6th of February or before declared over the next two weeks. A hard trade with Beef looking a cheap alternative at Export and at home.

Friday 26th July 2995 Forward

The first of our Scheduled Breeding Sales on Friday saw an unexpected number of potential buyers with the ring unable to accommodate all interested parties and buyers travelling from Yorkshire to Devon to take part. A good yarding up on the year saw the trade dominated by the Suffolks with aged Ewes and Double Theaves the trades of the day. Full mouth Ewes saw Suffolks from SF & AJ Deeming to £129, £128 and £127.50 whilst similar goods from CBE Prices, part dispersal £119.50. Mules to £85 from Graham Nichols. Double Theaves hotly contested topping at £134.50, £133 and £132 from Messrs Price again all for Suffolks. Mules to £110 from G Nichols.

A generally poor show of White Theaves today but buyers seemingly seeing the Continentals to be in vogue. Smart bred strong nut not extreme Texels from Will Gaydon saw £160 for a pen full, whilst Charollais x Texels from Rachae Turner £140. Texel x Mules from Clarke Farming Partnership topping at £145 and Chris Clayton £138. Suffolk Theaves a good enquiry with demand throughout and all trading above last years level, albeit quality correctly discounted as appropriate. Top of the run Messrs Deemings smartly presented Suffolks from Welsh Mules selling to £150.50 for a pen of 25 others £146, £142 and £140. Martin Woodward showed quality to £140 and Waddesdon Farms took £136.

Mules a tentative enquiry albeit all but a few on offer not looking ready to face the sale ring yet and perhaps needing another month of growth. Top again some £130 for lambed Theaves from Steve and Alison Deeming at £130 with various pens at the same level. Messrs Speakman, Essex also showed a pen of well marked dry Theaves to £129.

We trade again with NSA, and Nemsa sale on August 30th.. See you there.

Leaner ewes today seeing a more sticky trade, and trade should be monitored over the next fortnight leading up to the festival. A number of sheep have already been bought and put away for this.

Trade now likely to be subdued.
