2700 lambs in the alleys today as lambs continue to prosper in the current weather. And for a second week in a row no ques longer than 10 mins. Today though hundreds of lambs not booked in prior to the sale, which at the time of year with numbers out in force nationally isn't fair on buyers or Market Staff to not be prewarned of large numbers. The trade must be reported as hard work, with a very acceptable SQQ of just under 227p/kg a result of a trade that tailed off through the day as Export orders returned short of expectations in spite of the National increase in lambs on the Market. Our buyers today though standing up well to give competition throughout. Export best end lambs well competed today topping for Norfolk wanderer Sam Collie with 36kg to 278p/ kg ahead of Mrs SM Ellingworth showing finish and shape to 268p/kg at 38.5kg ahead of Woodys first draw of the season with 40kg to 263p/kg and Messrs Leadbeaters 42 and 38kg at 263p/kg. Shape lambs consistently over 240p/kg with trade dragged back today with a large number of O4H lambs on display. Weight well accepted topping at 47.5kg and 242p/kg from R & B Smith with Culworth Grounds 47kg to 241p/kg and M J Woodward 47kg 240p/kg equal with TH & R Gibbs and Culworth grounds 46kg to 240p/kg. Weighted lambs demand an indication for the need to ensure proper finish on lambs throughout. In the lump Export weights still getting past three figures seeing 42kg to £110 from DJ Leadbeater with 44kg from Woody to £106 equal with 45kg from F Hodgkin. 40kg from Woody also £105. Heavies nicely chased today topping out at £119 for 54kg from F Hodgkin. 50kg from MM Clarke & Sons saw £116 and R & B Smith £115 for 47.5kg. Trade easing back as Supply overtakes demand. Now is the time for vendors to ensure lambs have full finish.

Hoggs Still on parade and selling to 195p/kg and £80.



Just under the 1000 mark today and trade buoyed by a new face trying to come to terms with the independent and transparent trade seen in these aisles. He was very confused for the first hour. Trade must be reported as another step forward with Mules £5 dearer on the week and Lean Ewes of all sorts following suit. Sadly the best bred Ewes on show today all had more than too much cover and suffered a huge discount as a result. Top today for Texel tups selling to £119 for a trio from Midlands Environmental equal with a ewe from R & B Smith. Texel Ewes also £112 from DJ & BJ Leadbeater. Heavy ewes regularly over the £100 mark but generally all a little too rich. Top Suffolks today to £102 for Stratton Farms, Newbury. Suffolks generally trading high £90's with others £98.50 from FI & EJ Barnes. Mules stronger throughout to £86 for 10 from H Faulkner, Leighton Buzzard with £85 from F & J Clarke. The majority of Mules £77 to £82. Ewes continue as before with fat a major disadvantage but trade swift throughout and very much in the farmers favour for those who took the advice to hold back on sales a months ago.

THURSDAY 25TH JUNE STORE CATTLE SALE

A nice yarding in terms of numbers if not quality today. That said the quality dealt with accordingly and the highest priced Store cattle representing an increased trade once again. A Yarding of mainly Jersey derived dairy bred cattle and younger reared sorts. We started with a massive bang though in the Cow and Calf section. First in a 2011 Simmental Cow with a 14 day bull calf to £1480 from JM Cockerill followed by a nice consignment of Pedigree Limousin from the Warwick herd of Messrs Lowe. His first being a 2011 Cow with 7 month heifer calf at £2750, next a 2009 Cow with 7 month Bull calf to £2180 and a 2007 Cow with 6 month calf £1800. Into the Stores and the dairy bred and younger Cattle harder to place as the heat of the summer starts to make all wary 8 month Blue Steer though from B Dixon Studley to £650. Yearling Bucket reared Lim and Angus Steer to £790 from P Warden with Blue Heifers at only 12 months to £800. Then onto some nice Simmental Heifers from J Cockerill at 16 months making £1000 with others £945 and 14 months at £800. Simmental Steers from Ibbetson and Crawley took £920 for 13 month Steers with 14-15 month brothers £820. Sisters at 16 months took £805, £760 with yearlings £750. Another show of Herefords with some style from Tim Perkin topping at £850 for a pen of 16 months whilst 14 months took £750. A D Lane, Moreton in Marsh called upon these Shores for the first time with a consignment of South Devons topping at £800 for 14 months with others £730 and £715 at 13 months. Sisters to £600. Steers up from Cornwall saw £980 at 15 months for Limousin Steers with sisters £805. A Neary, Solihull tried this venue for his first time topping at £900 for a 17 month Simmental Steer with Heifers 17 – 18 month to £855. Roots, Leicester £900 for a pair of Angus Heifers at 20 months. RR Barrett & Son came up from Buckingham to take £1020 for 23 month Blue bucket Steer, whilst top ofr the day another first timer when TR & PD Baker sold South Devon Steers to £1000 at 23 months and £1100 at 27 months.
