CATTLE: 41 FORWARD



The first thing to say is that just over half way through the clean today, the weighbridge stabiliser bar seemingly broke. This resulted in those cattle passing over it afterwards weighing between 60 and 85KG wrong. This was a unavoidable mechanical error. All cattle weighed after this point where reweighed correctly and invoiced as appropriate. We have mechanics in to re-engineer the bridge this week. We can only apologise for an issue that was rectified immediately. On to the trade and a yarding that maintained quality really only in the heavies with a few exceptions. Weighted finish rewarded in the gross coloumn. Trade generally strong with only the lean O+ grade Steers much harder to sell during the Religious holidays which soon end.

Steers:

Shape and finish rewarded albeit U- the best on show and all with plenty of weight. Top today 246p/kg from D P Mitchell with a South Devon Steer weighing 670kg with a similar grade Charolais up from the Cotswolds to 238p/kg from T M Gaden others 226p/kg from Messrs Mitchell. Finish on display from Ratcliffe Farms to see 223p/kg at R grades others 210 to 223p/kg. In the gross weight totting up to £1677 from Ratcliffe Farms with Messrs Mitchell £1646 and Gaden £1578.

Heifers;

Not the show we have been having and some big girls in the aisles. Top today to 248p/kg for a Charolais from Thomas Gaden U grade whilst U- from Parry Walters saw 236p/kg and 231p/kg from JW & M Timbs, Oxfordshire, Parry also 230p/kg. R Grades a flyer and 228p/kg from B Caswell, Northampton with 228p/kg and Parry 226p/kg. O+ Grades with finish all travelling past 210p/kg. In the lump weight paying and upto £1581 and £1510 from Ratcliffe Farms Ltd. B T Caswell & Son £1395. OTM from Ratcliffe Farm saw lots of finish to return £1416.

Bulls;

Just a few Herefords from Alan Tacy today weighing 640kg at 200p/kg. Bulls needed and good trade rewarded.

Cows:

Mostly O Grades on show. O+ from Ann Wilson saw an Angus to 161p/kg and £1367. O grades to 145p/kg and 140p/kg and Cows regularly totting up.

PRIME HOGGS: 1990 FORWARD SQQ 302P/KG

Just under 2000 Hoggs today meeting a trade to top the nationals with an SQQ of 303p/kg and serious trade for meat and export weights throughout. Easter seemingly the driving factor for an increased trade and buyers out in force. Top today V J Roots with small well shaped 36.5kg to 349p/kg with D W Gurney & Son to 329p/kg at 37.5kg and the famous Norman Deeley 40kg to 335p/kg also taking 333 and 332p/kg at 38kg. Heavier Hoggs chased well if plenty of finish and again topped by Beltex Breeders V J Roots at 321p/kg for 46kg with Derbyshires own J Duggins 47.5kg to 309p/kg and Dadbrook Farm Limited 46kg to 304p/C W Lear & Partners 48kg to 302p/kg. Meat of all breeds rewarded and todays averages include all breeds but some of the top returns Romneys and Suffolks. Meat wanted throughout and if not for the over fat or unusual level of very lean the SQQ may have touched 310p/kg. In the lump today Export weights up to £148.50p/kg for 45.5kg from Messrs Roots who sold others at £144 for the same. Norman Deeley smiled at 45kg to £142. K Attfield, Willoughby saw 44kg to £139 with Messrs Duggins £138.50 at 44kg. Messrs Roots the days main man and topping out at a wonderful £170.50 from V J Roots at 66kg for Beltex others £160.50 at 54kg. P F Edwards £153 for 64 and 71kg with others £150.50 at 51kg. DJ Hull and Partners £150 for Blue Texels 52kg equal with heavies from D G Coombes, Witney. Trade very acceptable and another boost to a good year.

NOTE FROM RFM CHAIRMAN - Commission

Throughout the year prices ebb and flow according to Supply and Demand . At times when prices are low both farmers and markets struggle to balance the books but we all carry on waiting for better times.

During the past few months farmers have seen a considerable increase in values of their stock . A knock on effect has been an increase in commission being paid. Having reviewed the current trading climate we realise that our costs have not increased as fast as the current rates of Livestock. We therefore do not need to reap unrealistic Commissions and realise that this is a time for Producers to prosper not all subsidiaries that work with Farmers.

It has been decided by the Board to put a cap on commission paid per Lamb and on the Store Cattle for the next 12 months.

Our aim is continue to support all vendors on an equal footing whether selling 10 or 100 animals. We will review the situation in one years time For details call the office


