PRIME LAMBS: 2144 Forward SQQ 186p/kg

An improved yarding on last week with just over 2100 in the aisles. A note to vendors that we are trying to start selling as close to 10am as is possible with the added advantage to buyers that they can return lambs to kill. Today at 10am we had but a steady supply of customers with over 40% of stock turning up after 10am. Trade today a definite lift with export lambs a commodity in demand together with best Butchers sorts. Underfed lean lambs still hard to place and best marketed in the Stores. In the Euro section today some real shape to see Beltex from AJ & JM Young to 251p/kg at 34kg with DS & LE Wadland showing some real meat at 41kg to 235p/kg with R Richins 42.5kg at 231p/kg. Messrs Wadland also 43kg to 230p/kg and N Walker, Burford 40kg to 229p/kg. 157 lambs trading over 200p/kg today. In the heavies a top of 222p/kg for 50kg from DS & LE Wadland. P F Edwards, Stratford upon Avon 189p/kg at 46.5kg and Norman Deeley 48.5kg, 186p/kg. In the lump Euro lambs topping at £99 for 43kg Beltex from Messrs Wadland just ahead of R Richins, Oxford £98 for 42.5kg. Heavies the hardest thing to sell today with Supply nationally outstripping demand for the commodity. Top though £111 for 50kg from David Wadland with 59kg from R & B Smith 59kg to £104.50 and others at 55kg £97.50. Lamb trade with some real bite today and £4kg on the dead would not touch the export lambs. Midweight, heavy and lean lambs though well oversupplied.

The annual sale of Suckled Calves that saw an increased entry on the year with the majority of cattle having suffered the hard summer well. One or two consignments looking in backwards condition but on the whole the producers of the Midlands doing themselves proud. Our Thanks as ever to the Breed Societies for continued support and also to our Vendors. Special Thanks this year to our Judges Mr & Mrs Wildgoose whom travelled down from Nottinghamshire to do a very difficult job in picking his best Trios from large consignments, we as a firm along with the Vendors are incredibly grateful. Trade this year must be reported as far in advance of expectations with buyers seemingly keen to ensure they purchase cattle that are 'certainties' when facing either the Grid or the Butcher. This has been reflected throughout the Store season but highlighted even further today by the increased number of Buyers and the distance of Buyers travelling from the West Country and also the Welsh Borders. In line with rising cost of feeding best end Cattle perhaps £40 down on the year but this shortfall made up by the mid quality Cattle meeting an increased audience this year favouring calves over older Stores. Bulls started off at a real trade seeing 9 month Limousin from Dave Bull to £810 at 9 months whilst Simmental Bulls from Pete Incley £800 at 11 months and £1000 for 11 month old Limousins from B J Smith. Strong Charolais Steers from C & A Morley saw £850 at 7-8 months with sisters £635. D & GM Wright showed Simmental Steers at 9 months to £810 with others £800 for pens full. Grass fed Simmentals 8 – 9 months from Messrs Herbert saw a very happy vendor at £800 with others £770 and £760. Roland Sherratt showed his faithful following another good consignment that had taken the weather badly to top at £820 x for his Steers and a pen of 6 heifers at £675. Weighted Limousin Steers at 12 months from Richard Wright to £900 with Angus £800. The Friswells tee'd off this year with Stuart selling to a top of £900 at 7 months for Limousin with brothers £880. Steve and Elaine though topping at £1000 for 10 month old Steers with others £970 and £960 and heifers £875 and £850. Shipston on Stour vendor John and Sally Peebles took a marvellous £930 for a trio of 5 month old Limousin Steers with others £800 at 5 months. A marvellous heifer from the same at 6 months took £870. Martin and Harry Barnes dressed for the occasion and saw Charollais Steers at 7 months take £910 with Brothers £810 and Limousin £900. Heifers from the same home really rang the bell to see £970 for a pair of 8 month old Limousin and another at £960. JK Smith and Son showed 100 to top at £850 for a trio of Continental Steers at 8 months with heifers a top of £700 for Simmental. As ever BJ Smith showed the goods to see £1000 11 months with a trio at £955 and others £940, £905 and £890 whilst 10 month old heifers from the same breeding to £795. Last Suckled Calves in the ring from Messrs Semple saw trade hold throughout to top at £850 for 9 month old Limousin Steers with others £835. Those Cautious of the day perhaps not reading buyers demands correctly and seemingly missing out on perhaps the trade of the season. The message though clear that best bred cattle wanted but buyers are all mindful of the cost of keep. Sure Bets wanted in the gamble of Cattle feeding

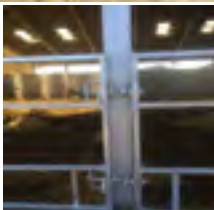
