Prime Hoggs:2480 Forward SQQ 214p/kg

The first venture into the Hoggs and a yarding of just shy of 2500 Hoggs forward. Benefitted by the extended dry period, lambs presented better today and the many belly clipped lambs selling to a premium. That said a poor yarding of lambs in the generality today with many consignments clearing up for the year and only the first few feeding men starting to arrive. Trade though very fast and miles ahead of prediction when referencing to deadweight quotes. In truth the Sqq today of 214p/kg could have another 5p attributed to it with last weeks show of lambs. A continued theme that the best end lambs continue to encourage the greatest audience. Another Abbatoir owner at ringside bringing the buyer number to 11 this week. Top in the Euro lambs today to 277p/kg for Beltex at 39kg from R Richins, Oxford who also sold 43kg to 260p/kg. 37kg shape from Richard and Judy Fountaine 259p/kg and J Wallis, Blakesley 40kg to 256p/kg ahead of W G King & Sons with overnight Texels at 44kg and 250p/kg. Heavy meated lambs again wanted selling to 228p/kg at 46.5kg from J Rutter & Son with others at 47kg 226p/kg. White Brothers, Atherstone back into the fold to take advantage of the end users at ringside when taking 220p/kg at 46kg. In the lump Euro lambs totalling £112.50 at 45kg from R Woodward, Langley with £112 at 43kg from R Richins and £110 for 44kg from W King, Aylesbury. Overall a top of £116 for 62kg from DJ & BJ Leadbeater. RAE Wilson saw 60kg to £112 and H L Goode & Son, Hockley Heath £112 at 59kg. Heavies a fine trade throughout with mostly all cutting lambs at best. Vendors should note little appreciation in value on lambs over 54kg and look to sell at optimum weights to avoid feeding unnecessary weigted lambs.

We now move to a period of Flux as the Post Christmas wobbles are dealt with. Please liaise with our Marketing team over the week. STARTING THIS WEEK. SUNDAY NIGHT LAIRAGE WILL ALLOW DELIVERIES PRIOR TO 4PM ONLY. This will allow the sorting and penning of sheep. From this week overnight Lairage will dictate compulsory belly clipping for all slaughter sheep. This is charged at cost at 60p per lamb, bedding and penning is free. Cull Ewes are to be charged at 50p for overnight lairage.
