A good yarding of just shy of 2500 Lambs averaging £109 with a real yarding or two halves some very smart meat trading at extreme rates. In truth a 20p divide between those fully finished and those lean lambs with killing percentages for some now plummeting below 44%. An Sog of 245p/ kg a mark of the high returns available for best meated lambs with lean lambs trading 232 to 237p/kg. Top today a real trade for meat and little plumbs from I M Allen Partners at only 29.5kg at 322p/kg. R Richins, Oxford selling his usual quality with super Beltex at 38kg to 316p/kg and Woodward 297p/kg. Nice meated 45kg from R Richins 289p/kg and V R Phipps, 43.5kg to 285p/ kg. Heavies the real headline of the day with Accounts from all buyers for weighted lambs on fire as Smithfield gets ready for the returns to school and the Cities begin to thrive once again. V R Phipps showed 50kg to 288p/kg and Di Hopcraft 47kg to 277p/kg equal with R Smith & Son, Lutterworth. V Phipps 271p/kg and E Brain, Stratford Upon Avon 271p/kg at 48kg. Lambs continuing to ring the bell and tot up well to see Export lambs £130 at 45kg from R Richins, Oxford and others £125. V R Phipps £124 for 43.5kg and 45kg £122.50 for C R Hill, Leicester. Heavies the story of the day. Near enough last man through the ring saw FJ Tombs & Son 57kg to £153.50 for a big pen full whilst one of the first men through saw V R Phipps 57kg to £153 and Smart meat from R & B Smith 59kg to £152 Ben Burtons run of 158 Primera Lambs topping at £150.50 and returning £126 avg 255.82p/ kg at 49kg kg going to show the value of fully meated lambs at the moment. Trade continues at pace and a trade here to match anything available. Please though book lambs in and make sure all lambs are fully finished. This year like no other we have seen surely the margins are available to feed the last finish into them.
