PRIME CATTLE: 27 HEAD

A disappointing entry forward, after last week's improvement in trade and all buyers present. Those that did show were rewarded with the best 2p dearer on the week, while commercial types would be a copper or two dearer.

BULLS: 7 HEAD

An extremely mixed selection in breed and weight, buyers were looking for all types and a fast trade ensued. Topping the section was a continental cross at 147p from Geoff Ratcliffe, Simmentals sold to 143p from Rob Evans. Top price per head was £866.50 for a Simmental.

STEERS: 6 HEAD

Numbers continue to disappoint and the entry was extremely mixed, topping the section was a red steer at 178p from Richard Fountaine.

HEIFERS: 18 HEAD

TOP SIX HEIFER AVERAGE 203.6P PER KILO.

The best heifers met excellent competition from a full ring of buyers. Topping the section and sale at 208p was a heavyweight Limousin, followed at 204p from Mr C. Clayton and Parry Walters. Top price per head was £1367 from Swinford. Others realised £1299 from Richard and Family. Commercial cattle off the grass are weighing 60-70 kilo's more on the year and grossing in the £900's.

Prime Lambs: Forward SQQ 174p/kg

Over 2000 lambs sold today to an SQQ of 174p/kg but in truth a harder trade than expected with over fat or under fed lambs very hard to shift and buyers lacking any depth of orders. Best lambs hotly contested though with best Export orders stronger on the week especially for shaped lambs of all weights and Ram lambs. In the Export weights a top of 233p/kg from Martin Woody Woodward with proper goods at 36kg ahead of Dabba Mitchell 39kg to 226p/kg and Passmore & Nunnerley 218p/kg. In the heavies shape and finish well rewarded but short of demand. Top 196p/kg at 48kg from Page Bros with 194p/kg at 47.5kg from B C Burton who sold others at 183p/kg. In the lump Export and light home weight lambs adding up to £88 for 39kg from Dabba Mitchell whilst J & R Gardiner, Shipston on Stour 43kg at £87 equal with Smith of Slapton. Heavies trade reduced as the Vegans descend upon the London Meat Markets but thankfully our end users standing up today to take £98 at 60kg from R & B Smith with £97 from Robert and Trudy Burman and £94 from at 48kg from Page Bros. Today 450 lambs selling over £82 which when you consider there is not a deadweight in the land you can hit this figure in just goes to pay tribute to our buyers support. Trade looking to open out a little but first the nations backlog must be cleared before we can see a clear picture for the next month ahead pre B***it.

CHRISTMAS SHOW RICH FRUIT CAKE

Oven Temperature: 300 F, 150 C, Gas 1-2

Ingredients:

12 oz/325 g Currants
4 1/2 oz/125 g Sultanas
4 1/2 oz/125 g Raisins
3 oz/75 g Glace Cherries
2 oz/50 g Candied Peel
A little lemon rind
7 1/2 oz/215 g Plain Flour
1/2 teasp Mixed Spice
1/2 teasp Cinnamon
6 oz/175 g Butter
6 oz/175 g Brown Sugar
3 Large Eggs
1 tablesp Brandy

1. Line an 8 inch round cake tin, using 2 thicknesses of greaseproof paper. Tie a double band of brown paper/newspaper around the outside.
2. Mix the currants, sultanas, raisins, cherries and peel.
3. Cream the butter, sugar and lemon rind until pale and fluffy.
4. Add the beaten eggs and the brandy, a little at a time, beating well after each addition.
5. Fold in the flour. Then fold in the fruit.
6. Put in to the prepared tin, spread evenly.
7. Place in the pre-heated oven on a layer of brown paper/newspaper, in the lower part of the oven. Cook for approximately 2 3/4 hours
8. When the cake is cooked, leave it to cool in the tin, and then turn out onto a wire rack.
9. Store by wrapping in greaseproof paper and place in an airtight tin.

When judging, the cake will have to be cut in half to see the distribution of the fruit etc. Inserting a skewer will only achieve the taste of the cake. The cake can still be covered in marzipan and icing ready for using at Xmas.
