Frankly flying with the yard of 2622 all in averaging £97 and an SQQ of 227p/kg!! Some good export Hoggs on show and massively well rewarded with extra buyers in the aisles and extra accounts opened that had not previously bought from Stoneleigh. Clean smart sheep at a massive premium and clipped sheep today averaging £2 per sheep more than those unclipped. In the Euro section a top of 278p/kg for 45kg Beltex from Dabba Mitchell. Neighbour, Ollie Pritchett saw 30.5kg Beltex at 366p/kg and D W Guerney & Son 43.5kg at 264p/kg. Today 355 Hoggs trading over 230p/kg!! In the heavies shape rewarded selling to 233p/kg for 48kg from first time callers with overnight Hoggs for J F Fyfe & Nephew, Winslow. Ben Nichols Blue Texels to 230p/kg at 49.5kg. In the lump Euro Hoggs right up the tree selling to £125 at 45kg from Dabba Mitchell with R C Hawes, Brackley to £112.50 at 45.5kg. D W Guerney & Son 42.5kg to £112 with Clark & Son, Bicester to £108 for 45kg. Overall Dabba Mitchell top at £125 for his 45kg but £122 for Josh Bailey, Lutterworth at 69kg with Benjamin D Nichols £119 for 54kg and Andy Mitchell £117.50. Today trade for all and a real farmers day with 12 buyers in the aisles sending Hoggs to 20 different processors of Hoggs. Competition is the key! Heavies a great trade but really no benefit to having a 55kg over a 52kg. 53kg plus Hoggs trading at a discounted rate if anything.

We are receiving several complaints from abattoirs and are also having trouble with ewes being sold heavily in-lamb, lambing in the market, or dying as a result of being heavily in-lamb. This not only reflects badly on farming as an industry, but trading standards are now actively seeking to pursue any problems with in-lamb sheep, potentially leading to prosecution.
