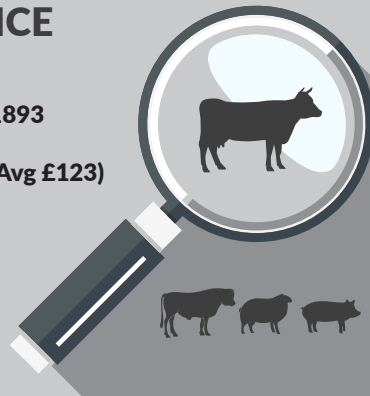

Top today for the Birthday boy Mr Henry Tustian breaking cover in the Midlands to see 332p/kg for 41kg ahead of J Elkington at 330p/kg at 38kg and David Wadland 41kg at 329p/kg. H Tustian 45kg to 322p/kg. Leach, Angela Russell and D Wadland all 319p/kg and today over 200 lambs breaking 300p/kg. Heavy lambs and finish the order of the day seeing 53kg take 299p/kg from F Hodgkin selling to Messrs Najib Ltd, Derby the same selling 49kg to 295p/kg and D Dashwood 53kg to 291p/kg. Middle weight finish well wanted with smart meat from Chris Whitehead seeing 47.5kg to 291p/kg even Mules to 257p/kg for weight today. Export lambs totting up today to see a all in avg including the 29 to 33kg runs taking £123.80!!! Export lambs saw 45kg to £145 from Henry Tustian with 43kg to £137 from D Wadland and 45kg Beltex from Chiltern Beltex to £136.50. Chris Whitehead 43.5kg to £135. A yarding in truth that showed a hard year with the weight and quality of Calves not what we usually see but farmers are not magicians and have faced a very difficult year in the calf production stakes. Trade though very much buoyant and as fast as we have ever seen with buyers from Wales the Borders and all over the Midlands stretching to Yorkshire. An all in avg for 4 months to 11 months to see £880 a phenomenal return.

We started with little Bulls that saw massive demand topping at £830 9 months for Simmentals from JK Smith with others £800. A great start from first time vendors DM Leedham, Leicester selling £890 for Charolais Steers at 6 months with sisters to the same £835. Natives not pushed saw Angus 6 months old Steers to £850 from Julian White, Market Harbrough and South Devons £820. Another first time vendor saw very honest Simmental Steers from Greyhound Estates to £875. Then came the girls and yet another first time vendor IS & S Francis, Worcestershire with a pen of 8 Limousin Heifers selling to £820.

JK Smith & Sons glad to be back with the well supported annual consignment topping at £1125 for Steers 8 months of age followed by £1030 a trio at £1005 and £960 for Limousin followed by the Simmentals from the same to £995, £930 and £900. Limousin Heifers to £1000 and £990 with others £940 and £900 and Simmentals to £815. A proper show of breeding from JD Stephens saw Limousin 8 month Steers to £1000 for 4 and brothers another 6 at £940. Real sorts from yet another new man J Snoxall, Market Harbrough saw Charolais Steers to £1145, £1105 and £1040 with sisters £1035 and £100 at 8-9 months of age. Mr Alderman made the journey up to sell Blondes at 11 months to £935 and Simmentals 10 months to £975. Pete Inley showed Simmentals to £960 and £900 at 10 -11 months with Limousin £905. Then onto the Friswells selling a large draw. Topping at £1090 for Limousin Steers and also Heifers at only 8 months of age. Other Steers £1045 and £1000 with no end trading £955 to £900 at 6 - 9months. Heifers the pick of the families show selling to £1090, £1080 and £1045 with others £990, £980, £970, £945 and rows over £900. Then the Champion, a loyal Customer getting his rewards selling a Limousin Steers at 7 months to £1200 with Blues £900 and Angus £850.

Quality always on show from the Morley Charolais seeing Steers to £1060, £1040 and £1010 and Heifers £950 and big pens £955. Roland Sherratt the most genuine of runs saw Charolais Steers 8 months old to £1000 and £1045 with others £970 and 14 in a row over £950. Sisters to £880. Salers showed promise from H Smith & Son, Stratford Upon Avon taking £950 at 10 months with Charolais Heifers £900 only 7 months. W R Eales first Suckled Calf showing a prosperous one at £975 and £925 for 8 month Simmental pure Steers with a run of brothers £900. Complete forage based systems and breeding not feeding the strap line for the annual Herbert, Brackley Consignment of Facebook fame. This hardy run topped at £985 for Simmental Steers with pens full at £950 and bigger pens at £900. Trade start to finish and buyers in abundance.
