## **CATTLE : 31 Forward**

A short entry due to 6 day Standstill and harvest was on offer to a good company of butchers and wholesalers all complaining of slow shop trade with the barbecue trade the only highlight.

**Bulls:** A short entry was easily sold, topping the section was a black bull from Hillside.

**Steers:** JOHN TOPS THE SALE 250P FOR A LIMOUSIN

Quality was extremely varied with the entry including some terrific butchers cattle which found a ready market, and some awful shaped, but well fed black & white's which selling between 160-167ppk were easily last week's trade. Star of the show was a superb handy-weight black steer from John Wrench and Family which after fierce competition at ringside realised 250p. Heavyweights from Richard Fountaine made 234p. As ever numbers are needed to supply a growing market at ringside.

**Heifers:** Same story as the steers, competition everywhere for all types and more are needed to supply demand from ringside. The section was topped by a grass-fed Limousin at 221p from Richard Fountaine with market regular Parry Walters trailer-load averaging 213p.

**Cows:** A short entry of varied quality met good competition at ringside which saw several buyers absent. The section was topped at 132p for a Charolais Cow from Mr Day which realised £1188.00, others sold to 130p from Richard Wright. Herefords sold to £923 from Richard Heckford M.B.E. Dairy cows sold to 99p for out of parlour types from Messrs Hill, Firs Farm, Farmers, as said in the report we have plenty of buyers at ringside for all types of cattle, and as land work takes preference, we are open from 6.30a.m. on sale morning to receive stock. ## **SHEEP:2995**

### **PRIME LAMBS: 2243 Forward SQQ 197p/kg**

First things first. A big thank you to everyone who assisted and helped weigh the lambs today. Obviously when you turn the bridge on at 5 in the morning and find someone has cut the wires to it is not ideal. As a business and with vendors good grace and help we did address and overcome the issue. Buyers also thanking the droving team and vendors for their help in the matter, perhaps the explanation for us posing just about the dearest SQQ in the country on a falling trade of 197p/kg. Numbers massively up at 2300 or so as farmers across the country piled lambs into markets to lessen the load in the ever increasing drought conditions back at the farm. A yarding of two different halves. Meated fed lambs saw some real nice runs today but at the other end woefully lean lambs. Lean lambs and those grading o-simply finding no audience in this 2018 season. In the Euro spec a top ppk of 226p/kg for 43kg from AEJ & FJ Claridge with 224p/kg 44kg to Di Hopcraft. Heavies a much preferred commodity and 47kg to 212p/kg from Messrs Claridge as old buyers returned today with Stone House Farming 208p/kg for 48 and 46kg. Today weighted lambs 43kg plus wanted and the 37kg to 39kg at a major discount. In the lump Euro lambs to £98 for 44.5kg from Di Hopcraft whilst Messrs Claridge 44kg and Fountaine 45kg to £98. Overall no real heavies today but a single 60kg £110 for T Wood whilst MM Clarke & Sons 55kg to £107 equal with Boulton Bros.
