Best end native Bulls a real trade with Stuart Warden selling Angus to £255, with others to £200 from Pete Hemmings. No real best end native Heifers forward today. Rearing Bulls actively £140-£180 with rearing Heifers £70-£110.

Prime Hogs: 2070 Forward SQQ 259p/kg

Just over the 2000 Hogg mark today and numbers harder to find but drawn from far afield to top the number up with callers today from as far as Devon in attendance. Hogg trade predicted to hold due to National number shortage but crashes on the Stock Market providing an unforeseen margin for export as the pound devalued. The resulting factor a increased Export trade and an SQQ of 259/kg. That said home trade Wholesalers also increasing purchase power today. Today some smart stock on show but perhaps the dearest the other end with North Country Mule Ewe lambs cashed at £119 and plenty in the £100 to £110 range. 300 Romneys in the averages today and again meeting a blistering trade. In the Export weight Hogs a top for Beltex from Oxford saw R Richins 40kg to 355p/kg ahead of Sam Collie with overnight bellied lambs at 39.5kg to 329p/kg. Local producers White Bros of Atherstone saw properly meated Hoggs take 41kg at 329p/kg and 42.5kg 315p/kg. Heavies saw a top 296p/kg for 46kg overnight Beltex from Adam Mitchell, Naesby whilst Ross Sizmur of Okehampton Devon saw 290p/kg for 62kg Texel and others 50kg to 266p/kg ahead of wonderfully presented Hoggs from Fred White, Atherstone at 46.5kg and 263p/kg. Producers today realising the Massive gross figures totting up with Export weight Hoggs to £142 for 40kg from Mr R Richin with Beltex and White Bros pleased with there RFM Business to see £134 and £133.50 for 41 and 42kg. Fernhill Farms, Banbury saw £133.50 at 43kg. Heavies wanted today but mainly by Exporting firms, with our very strong Home trade Customers unable to live with the trade. Top man Mr Sizmur seeing a whopping £180 at 62kg with D P Mitchell & Son, Rugby take 66kg at £145 and Jack Lombard, Banbury £140 at 52kg. 56 kg from Mr Sizmur, Devon also £139. Trade in general hot and the mobile phones working in farmers favour as continuous calls to frustrated abbatoirs by those at the pen side resulted with constant affirmation that numbers where needed.

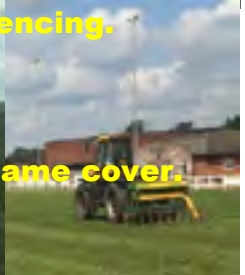
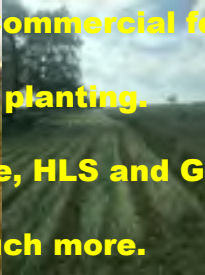
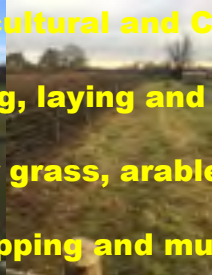
