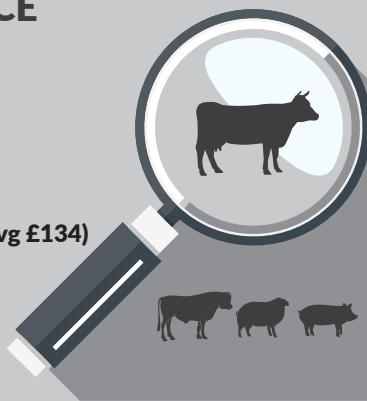

The day after the weekend before with record Kill numbers on the Saturday and Sunday for the Quarbani Festival. In truth a tailored number in the yard with numbers certainly not in demand. Instead a scaled back yarding of lambs meeting the countries highest trade at 315p/kg SQQ, surely better than large numbers facing a limited number of buyers. Back to normality next week with trade likely to find its plateau in the coming week. Today a very small buyer core but with a limited demand. Best lambs well chased and a top beating the prodigal 400p/kg mark selling at 403p/kg for 36kg from P Jarrom with 37.5kg from R Calcott to 368p/kg and S M Ellingworth 37kg at 358p/kg. Heavies in great vogue and better supported than the light lambs selling to 337p/kg at 46kg from E Brain & Sons Ltd with BF Humphrey & Sons 46kg 333p/kg and S M Ellingworth 49kg at 331p/kg and 50kg from S & J Farming. An all in avg of £134 today a smart return with Export weights to £150 for 44kg for B G Humphrey & Sons with others £148 at 43kg. MM Clarke & Sons 45.5kg £148 equal with BF Humphrey & Sons. Heavies to a £170 at 56kg from E Brain & Son Ltd with RAE Wilson & Son 55.5kg at £166 and S & J Farming £164.50. Lamb trade on the day very acceptable but in truth we would have struggled to sell too many numbers on this very precise day.
