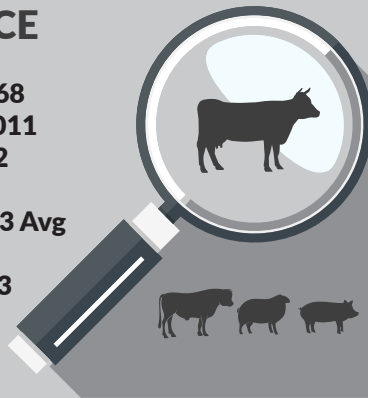

Another fantastic entry of Clean and Bulls. With all category's selling well beyond expectation. (Well mine anyway). The dearest on the day in my opinion would be the commercial cattle. Angus Fed cattle from Ed Hull selling to 280ppk. Other commercial cattle selling as standard between 255/280ppk. The best cattle again remain in the league of their own. Frank Page of Northampton sold his fantastic run of cattle to 337ppk. Simon Johnson, Lutterworth back on song with his home bred heifers to £2011.02.

Steer department - RJ Morris of Lutterworth topped with an 800kg limousin at £2168. Coming back again to the top charts is Frank Page this time with a Steer at 319ppk. A sharp drop in numbers as grass comes back and producers look to add cover to lambs. The lambs on show mainly fed and weighing as such with a yard dominated by weight Trade though almost exclusively the required commodity with Export weights remaining a much harder commodity. Today an SQQ of 257p/kg testament to the number of fed lambs on show and extra new accounts on ringside despite a steady in trade throughout the land. Top today Shape from A J Geary, selling 39kg to 297p/kg with PD & DM Hopcraft 43kg and Ian Wain 44.5kg to 292p/kg. Export weights generally a harder sell with most trading 240 to 250p/kg. Heavies a different story with a top of 48kg from L C Threadgold & Son at 313p/kg with others the same weight 299p/kg. 50kg from Pete Inley 294p/kg and 49kg from C Clayton to 292p/kg. An all in avg of £119 for the day a highlight of an amazing trade and also how heavy the lambs are weighing that are fed properly. Export lambs topping at £130 for 44.5kg from Ian Wain and 45kg from H J Spencer & Sons selling to £127 with Di Hopcraft 43kg to £126 and J K Smith & Sons best run of 190 lambs seeing 45kg to £125.50. Heavies really the order of the day with competition for the quality throughout. Top today again to L C Threadgold with his Blue Texel Sired sheep. 57kg to £163 selling to C Humphries and Sons, Essex. R Burman showed meat at 58kg to £156 and RAE Wilson 61kg to £155 equal 66kg for T Paton & Sons. Humphrey Livestock weight and shape to 55kg at £154. A real trade for a week that is traditionally the hardest selling week of the year. Meat the key though throughout.

Home baking – Fruit Cake

Ingredients:

225g (8oz) S R Flour
1 tsp mixed spice
¼ tsp ground cinnamon
¼ tsp ground nutmeg
175g (6oz) butter
175g (6oz) soft brown sugar
1 tbsp black treacle
1 tsp each grated orange and lemon rind
4 eggs
550g (1 ¼ lb) mixed dried fruit
100g (4oz) chopped mixed peel
50g (2oz) glacé cherries
15ml milk

To finish:

Brandy to feed

Method:

Pre-heat the oven to 150°/300°F/Gas 2. Grease and line an 8in (20cm) deep round cake tin with a double layer of greased greaseproof paper.

Sift flour with spice, cinnamon and nutmeg.

Cream butter with sugar, treacle and orange and lemon rind.

Beat in eggs, one at a time, and adding 1 tbsp of sifted dry ingredients with each other. Stir in mixed fruit, chopped peel, and cherries.

Fold in dry ingredients alternately with milk.

Transfer to prepared tin and smooth top with a knife. Bake for 4 – 4 ½ hours or until a skewer comes out clean. Leave in tin for 15 minutes then turn out onto a wire cooling rack.

When cool, pierce the cake at intervals with a fine skewer and feed with a little brandy. Wrap the completely cold cake in a double layer of greaseproof paper and again in foil and store in a cool place for up to 3 months, feeding at intervals with more brandy.

Leave undecorated.
