

Meat and weight well chased with a top of £181 for Beltex from V J Roots at 67kg with DG Coombes then selling £180,£176,£174.50,£174 and £173.50. # PRIME LAMBS: 2518 FORWARD SQQ 315P/KG AVG £129

A large increase in numbers today as producers scrambled to sell lambs all coming fit together. Seemingly this coincides with a massive slow on the Continent and at Home as sales slump perhaps in preparation of the Quarbani Festival. Trade hard work with limited demand despite increased numbers. An SQQ of 315p/kg though a nice return on the day. Best end lambs well chased and plenty trading 340p/kg plus with only the light lambs dragging trade backwards. Meat and finish a key with last week small lamb accounts killing at 44.4% only.

Meat a massive draw and proper weight and finish from BJ & IS Wain saw Beltex at 366p/kg for 41kg and 364p/kg at 44kg. B Nichols feeding lambs hard this year and reaping rewards at 41kg to 354p/kg whilst weight and shape from AL & AR Wolfe saw 45kg to 353p/kg. Heavies a nice trade with extra weight a real advantage today with 48kg to 349p/kg from Philly Batchelor whom also sold 49kg to 344p/kg and J Dronfield 344p/kg ahead of J Boulton at 343p/kg. An all in avg of £127 despite a wealth of very light lambs once again as people rush to meet the trade. Export Lambs topping at £160 for 44kg from BJ & IS Wan with Messrs Wolfe 45kg to £159 and D G Coombes run of 320 lambs seeing his Export weights to £152.50 for 45kg, J & S Livestock up from Berkshire to sell 44kg at £152. Overall a massive £180.50 for 55.5kg from AL & AR Wolfe, Leicester with Hyde Lane Farms 56.5kg at £175 and RJ Batchelor 49kg to £168.50 and K Attfield 52kg £168. Trade very acceptable for the time of year and hopefully the slump is just a pre Festival fall. Lambs though now should be drawn to meat and in excess of 40kg only.


