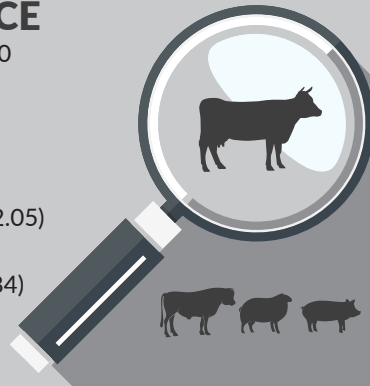

## **PRIME LAMBS: 1680 FORWARD SQQ 401P/KG AVG £184**



A larger number this week although a two tier yarding with the feeding men starting to draw numbers whilst the lambing Shepherds using today as a final clear up day of those left overs from last year. Trade stepping forwards again with meat a step dearer again although the averages disadvantaged by a large number of Store framed Hoggs forwards. Meat Export weights trading to a top of 500p/kg at 40kg from DJ Hull & Partners, Essex with Di Hopcraft 38kg to 495p/kg. Proper meated sheared Hoggs from Leam Farming to 475p/kg at 40kg and PJ Incley 43kg to 467p/kg. Meat Export weights regularly 420p/kg plus with leaner sort 370- 390p/kg. Weight well chased and PJ Incley 46.5kg to 484p/kg with others 46kg at 460p/kg. Weight shape and meat down from Leek supplied by Poplar Farming saw 457p/kg at 52.5kg. Meat and weight regularly 450p/kg plus with leaner Hoggs trading around 400p/kg regularly. In the Lump Export Hoggs to £208 at 45.5kg for DJ Hull & Partners with J Brown up from Aylesbury selling 45kg at £203 and PJ Incley 43kg at £201. Overall weight totting up to see a top of £240 at 52.5kg for fed Hoggs from Poplar Farming 52.5kg. JF Fyfe & Nephew then £235 and £232 with Greenfields of Twycross £230 for two pens on the spin and Alex Edwards, Uttoxeter 53kg to £230. Trade for meat but lean Hoggs swiftly falling away and vendors encouraged to take advantage of the trade for fully finished Hoggs.

Lambs;

A larger show of Spring Lambs today well received and returning 470p/kg SQQ for a deadweight equivalent as high as we have seen in this Country. Some questionable quality forwards as some Lambs short on finish and drawn early. The other half proper meated and finished fresh Spring Lambs very well received. Export and Butcher quality topping at 528p/kg at 39kg for Beltex from E Brain & Son, Stratford upon Avon just pipping PK Cobley, Leicester at 524p/kg. S Harrison across from the Cotswolds to see 514p/kg at 38.5kg with FE & EJ Barnes & Son also breaking the 500p/kg mark. Export weights with any class trading 485p/kg plus. Leaner short of meat Export weights 450 plus throughout. Weight as ever at this time of year the hardest commodity to sell as the Hoggs continue to provide a cheaper option for processing and catering Sectors. Top gross though still very impressive selling to £225 for Dutch Spotted 51kg from RJ Wright with Amy Wright 51kg at £212. FE & EJ Barnes 49kg at £210 with RJ Wright 42kg at £210. 17 extra pens selling over £200.
