SPRING LAMBS 1121 FORWARD SQQ 303P/KG AVG £137



Numbers remain tight and as a result a trade of 303p/kg well ahead of any comparison with a deadweight comparison over £640p/kgdw.

In truth a harder sell today with lambs short on meat and very bery wet from the weekened. Shortage of numbers teh only thing holding trade up.

Exporrt lambs with meat well traded and all around the 300p/kg mark with the lean light home trade lambs less on the week trading 280-290p/kg. Top 41kg at 367p/kg nd 39kg 359p/ kg for R Richins Beltex. T H Morris 41kg at 341p/kg equal with P J East.

Weight still easily sold but mainly as it is the single commodity with full finish. Weight and shape for A K Wilson with 56kg at 321p/kg for Rouge whilst B T Caswell & Son 47kg at 321p/kg. and MM Clarke & Sons 46kg at 313p/kg. Lean Weight 280-290 and meat around 300p/kg.

In the lump the first dip under a £140 avg for many many weeks and months but still £137. Export topping at £152 for 43.5kg for R Richins 41kg at £150.50 and MM Clarke & Sons 45kg at £146. Heavies topping at £180 for 56kg from A K Wilson and 57kg from B T Caswell £172.50 with 62kg £172 for Messrs Clayton. AR & J Collett £170 on three occasions.

More needed but simply put meat must be the key. Trade well ahead of alternatives with Abbatoirs really feeling the annual lull this year.


