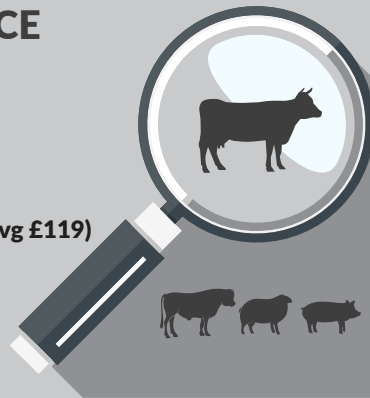

On Monday 1st August 2022 Rugby Farmers Auction held their weekly sale of Primestock.
104 Cattle forwarded included -

9 Young Bulls to 287ppk or £2244.34
24 Prime Bullocks to 309ppk or £2135.94
28 Prime Heifers to 326ppk or £2053.80
43 OTM Cattle 278ppk or £2587.53

Rugby Farmers Mart breaking the market trend and seeing no resistance in the beef trade. All cattle forward sold to a phenomenal trade. A fantastic entry of quality and finish on all cattle forward today. Nearly 2 1/2 years on since the start of the covid pandemic the beef and sheep trade is starting to deal with its first year post covid along with now a cost of living crisis. With wholesalers already seeing a difference in sales patterns with premium high end cuts, harder to sell and values going down. While mincing and cheaper cuts being easy to place which is completely out of trend for the time of year. Young Bulls - 9 Forward - A smaller show of bulls forward, but some quality throughout. FK Baxter, Leicester had some fantastic bulls selling to 287ppk or £2234 others from the same home at £1939 and £1738.50. L Smith, Stratford on Avon sold to £2130.48.

Prime Bullocks - 24 Forward average 270.287ppk.

With over 3rd of bullocks forward selling over 280ppk. It was Frank Osbourne who topped the day at 309ppk with a 624kg Limousin purchased by Andrew Mutch of Mutch Meats. 20% of Bullocks forward sold over £2000. With H Smith, Warwickshire, topping the day at £2135.94 with a 734kg Charolais purchased by D Sandham Trading Ltd. D NJ & HJ Parrott, Cherington not far behind with Limousin Bullocks to £2129, £2073 and £2070.

Prime Heifers - 28 forward average 272ppk.

Again it must be noted what a cracking entry of quality and finish. Nigel & Simon Johnson, Lutterworth topped the day with as good a heifer I've seen for a longtime in both finish and style a homebred Limousin heifer at 630kg sold to 326ppk or £2053.80 purchased by Robert Leach of Carpenters Farm Butchers. CJ & MT Clayton, Byfield had some lovely butchers heifers at 319,313,311ppk.

OTM & Cows.

42 OTM, Cull Cows & Stock Bulls forward.
Another cracking trade, deadweight firms pulling the price back while market remains strong. Ed Hull, Tops the Stock Bulls and OTM heifers. His Charolais Stock Bull sold to £2587.52 and OTM Hereford Heifer to £1444.40.

Cull Cows sold to £1840 for a sweet Blue Cow or 278ppk from A G Farmer, Melton Mowbray also £1724.
Ed Hull again near the top with his Dairy Bred Herefords at £1691, £1662, £1639 & £1609.

Numbers shorter on the week as Farmers heed dropping returns and look to focus on Harvest. Trade a flyer in real terms with an SQQ of 268p/kg returning a deadweight equivalent miles past £6 per kg and an all in avg of £119 a super return at the current times and for what was again a yarding of far too many lean poor percenting lambs. In truth a reduced yarding essential with numbers coming out in the north and the afternoons national trading 10 -20p/kg less. Export markets still very sluggish with today's yarding nearly all destined for home consumption. Best end shape in massive demand seeing a top of 352p/kg for 33kg Beltex for IM Allen, Leicester with G R Fountaine & Son, 323p/kg and Messrs Allen 39kg 321p/kg. John Barnett down from Leicester saw 37 to 40kg at 305p/kg to 300p/kg. Heavies again the desired commodity seeing M Hoyle sell Texels at 46kg to 300p/kg and RF Wilson 52kg at 299p/kg. M Hoyle 51kg to 294p/kg and A Geary 47kg to 294p/kg. In the lump Standard weights to £130 at 44kg for M Hoyle. B C Burton 44.5kg at £128.50 with JJV Hollands 43.5kg to £128 equal with Showell Farms and D Wadland. Heavies a smart trade topping at £161 for 59kg from S Wise with Texels and W & M Emery best draw of the year saw £156 for 57kg with R Wilson Charollais at 52kg to £155.50 and P Mac 58kg to £153. Meat the order of the day. A little more demand on show today and a massive gap opening in trade between those fed and those not.

FIRST ANNUAL BREEDING SHEEP FAIR: 2964 FORWARD



The first Annual Breeding Sheep Sale saw a packed Ring from across the Desert land of the Midlands and West. In truth very few in a position to buy Sheep with little to no keep to accommodate new arrivals. A Trade that for what was sold would be a fair reflection for quality albeit a disappointing 85% only clearance. We started with a proper run of Aged ewes this year from D Coombes seeing FM Suffolks top at £160 and 2 x £150 then onto the Mules and large pens full at £140. White Faced sheep a more reserved demand this year seeing better end Tex x trading £170 for Passmore and Nunnerley and W Gaydon. More Continental bred saw Beltex x from JB Elkington in large pens £200 - £190 and C Clayton £200. L Threadgold Blue Texels to £212 whilst top for section a massive £300 for Pure bred Texel Theaves from Messrs Leadbeater. Texel x regularly around the £150 to £160 mark with lesser quality £130 to £150.

Suffolks much the same selective trade as the Texels seeing best end top at £215, £200 and £190 from R J Batchelor. Waddesdon Estates to £182 and £180 with D Aries £179. I Newton £188 and £185 and RH Mole £180. Suffolks regularly £150 to £168 with lesser sorts not fit to Tup well under.
