First things first, Congratulations to our Lamb Vendors Messr Clark, Todenham for their sons, Arther's, call up to the England Rugby Senior Squad!!!

Trade hitting a slight roadblock with the level of current trading being harshly resisted by Exporters and more drastically by London and the Catering trade. Heavy Hoggs as a result a harder fix and less Customers for them. A poor show on the whole today with a lot of small lean lambs forwards all of which would be woeth perhaps £5-10 more in the Store lambs.

Meat still the key and an SQQ of 344p/kg equal to a deadwith of circa 730p/kgdw. Export lambs the easiest sold and meat rewarded to see a top of 420p/kg from R Kellet at 44kg for Pure Texels. Joshua Jack up from Bucks saw a real following for real meat Beltex at 411 and 405p/kg for 45kg with leicestershires A Green 400p/kg fro Blue Texels and Stratford Upon Avon's JJV Holland 40kg at 398p/kg. Meat well rewarded and best fed trading all over 360p/kg. with Mule bred lambs fully finished 350-335p/kg and lean lambs 320-330. Common Lambs taking the only real hit of the day in teh Export section. Heavies out of favour today with less men wanting to process Heavies in a difficult trade. Heavies to 379p/kg for Rouge from C Stubbs with 371p/kg at 48kg for S Wise and Texels and Tommy Tustian 47kg at 366p/kg.

Export Lambs topping out in the lump at £185 for 44kg from R Kellett with Joshua Jack 45kg at £182 and MK Gray 45kg at £170. Heavies still totting and a real meat run of weight from Lincolnshire Flack Master PR Baker selling to a mssaive avg up on the week despite a fall in trade. Paul taking £200 at 70kg, 64kg at £198 and 65kg £192 equal with JK Smith & Sons.

Trade hard on the selling side but hopefully Christmas Credit soon paid off and trade may stabalise.

Today, 600 lambs were clipped, all selling at a premium. The clipping service will be available Sunday night and Monday, from now on.
