On Monday 20th June Rugby Farmers Mart held their weekly sale of Primestock.

Prime Bulls - 21 forward sold to £2238.60 or 293ppk.

An outstanding entry of Bulls forward with a selection of Bulls to suit every customer. In simple terms the trade witnessed would be un rivalled by any outlet in the country.

The mixed show of bulls saw over half grossing over £1750.

Nigel Hollick of Honesberie Farms took the lime light of the day with his 5 fantastic home bred Limousin bulls topping the market at £2238.60 or 293ppk these were purchased by Mr Andrew Mutch, from Mutch Meats Witney.

Nigel sold bulls to £1902, £1857 £1714.

Lester Smith, Stratford Upon Avon also forward with fantastic home bred Charolais Bulls wasn't far behind at £2135, £2131 and £1958.

Heifers 20 forward sold to 317ppk or £1921.

Last weeks SQQ top of the tree and this week a rare increase in trade for June with a lift to SQQ of 325p/kg placing the avg export lamb £6.40 above deadweight comparison. Returning valued Customers at ringside and a better quality of lamb moved trade forward at pace seeing best end lambs top at 371p/kg for Blue Texels from A F Neal, Smart shape from Phil and Jake Davenport saw 38kg at 368p/kg and more Blues 368p/kg from Messrs Neal. John Barnett 36kg Texels at 365p/kg and BF Humphrey & Sons 41kg 362p/kg, and Julian White 38kg to 361p/kg. Weight a real craved commodity currently with Lambs struggling to progress. Weight to 347p/ kg at 49kg for RJM Mawby with Rosie Leach 50.5kg at 344p/kg and Baxter & Smith 50kg to 342p/kg. J Peebles, Shipston 47kg at 340p/kg. An all in avg of £135 quite remarkable for the time of year and feeding lambs definitely paying. Export Lambs to £157 at only 44kg from BF Humphrey & Sons whilt 45kg from MR Grindal & Son £155 whist Greenfields 45.5kg £153 and Alan Collett 45kg at £152.50. J C Hutchinson 45kg to £152. Heavies in serious demand today and weight seriously paying to see a milestone moment of Spring Lambs to £206 for 68.5kg from FJ Tombs & Son selling to B Wilson on behalf of C Humphrey & Sons, Essex. Greenfields of Twycross with weight and shape at £190 for 56.5kg and R Mawby £181.50 for 54.5kg, F Tombs & Son £180 at 57.5kg. Trade likely to now dip away with this year Quarbani unable to kill Lambs at all and instead focusing on Hoggs and Ewes. Lambs should now be marketed over 40kg and fully meated.


