A few less about as the consistent rain washes the lambs through and shy of meat. Consignments of fed lambs though very welcome with travelled lambs from Sussex and Somerset amongst the local Counties all very welcome. A large step forward in the SOO to 262p/kg. Best meat well chased and although buyers keen for meat today but still reporting slower than usual Sales. Best lambs in strong demand and the quality of finish today much better. Top today saw Beltex from MJ Woodward at 328p/kg at 40kg with DJ & ST Webb showing meat at 38kg for 316p/kg and SLAM Farming 43kg to 314p/kg. Meat fully finished regularly 280p/kg plus with nice export quality trading 250 to 270p/ kg dependant on finish. Meat the key and meat the only thing needed. Butchers have no trade for bones!! Weight continues to be the sought after commodity and today a top in the weighted lambs of 313p/kg for 53kg Beltex from G Fell with Rob Burman 46kg to 309p/kg with GE Farming on over from Norfolk to take 48.5kg at 309p/kg. An all in avg of £119 requiring a deadweight avg weight of 22.4kg!! Export weight lambs today selling to a top of £135 for 43kg and £130.50 for 45kg from SLAM Farming, £129.50 at 45kg from Humphrey Livestock and 41.5kg £129 for R Richins with 45kg from Hyde Lane Farms £129. Overall a top of £170 for SLAM Farming at 61kg aND £170 for 69kg from BJ & IS Wain. G Fell 53kg at £166 and Hyde Lane Farming 60kg to 258p/kg. Mr Holt up from Sussex saw 61kg to £155 and Mr Gorringe on the same lorry 53kg to £154. Meat the key throughout.
