SPRING LAMBS 854 FORWARD SQQ 297P/KG AVG £133

Numbers very hard hit throughout with Bluetongue zones expanding on Friday evening meaning that many of our Customers are now unable to use RFM. We have been in discussions with the Ministry for 3 weeks and hope that they will see sense with a solution this week allowing all customers to use RFM going forwards.

Lamb trade being depressed everywhere with Slow Sales and cheap Zone lambs hitting the Market as processors take advantage. Best end meat well chased and a load from Oxford based W Selmes well received, selling to a fast trade for meat shape and weight.

Top today 340p/kg for 43kg from W Selmes with P F Edwards 42kg at 340p/kg and NE & SJ Lewis 42kg meat at 331p/kg. Messrs Selmes and Hopcraft then dealing at 320 to 330p/kg. Meat all trading 310p/kg plus with Export weight with less backs trading 290-300p/kg and lean lambs and lightweights hard to shift trading in the 280's.

Heavies a good trade still but hardest hit by Bluetongue deductions with London full of Heavy lambs at massive discounts. Top though for Exporters taking weight and small Butchers seeing 49kg at 318p/kg for W Selmes with Nigel & Harry Redfern 51kg at 314p/kg. 52.5kg for Messrs Selmes 309p/kg. Weight with meat still hitting 300p/kg but the next grade down trading in the 280p/kg regions and harder to fit.

An all in Avg of £133 still very respectable and way above this time last year. Export lambs to £150 for 45.5kg from Messrs Selmes whom also sold at £146 for 3 pens on the trot 43 - 45kg. Humphrey Livestock 45.5kg to £143.

Plenty of Export lambs trading £130 plus mark. Weight pays though and top today £179 at 68kg for HC & CW FARMING ahead of Shepherd Extraordinaire Tess Thurston with 60kg at £166 and Messr Selmes 52.5kg at £162. Messrs Edwards and Redfern both breaking £160 also.

We await the progress of Blue Tongue Zones and Red Marketing this week and will update all customers in the coming days.

Real quality forwards today and Buyers keener to purchase as the weather turns a little more seasonal.

Starting with Cows & Calves, R & S Farming sold Cows with 4-5 month Calves at foot to top at £2200 for a 2010 Hereford Cow and Blue Heifer calf whilst a 2011 Hereford with twins sold at £2300.

Young Cattle the hardest sold with Pneumonia on everyones mind, but those with strength well chased at £1100 10 month Limousin Steers from T Preston with sisters to £805. Salers 14-15 month Steers at £1430 before a super run from Henry Tustian saw 12m Blue Steers to £1685 and Limousin £1650 with others £1450 to £1590. Heifers a real trade and showey sorts to £1840 at 14 months with 13 month Blues £1700 and 15 month Limousin £1600.

Many more wanted but Blue Tongue Zones need monitoring.


