The beginning of a slow as buyers started to stay at home with decreased order books. Last week a yarding of quality to be proud of, this week a real dearth in quality and an incredibly poor varding of meat. An Sgg of 391p/kg mainly compensated by the massive premium paid on best end Hoggs. Lean Hoggs hardest hit by the retraction in trade with lightweight City Hoggs and lean Export Hoggs now trading 15p back on the week at 375p/kg. Top today for real shape from J & H Tustian selling 38kg at 526p/kg whilst R & P Tvacke sold 37kg plums at 508p/kg and VJ Roots 39kg at 503p/kg. Messrs Tyacke also 500p/kg at 40kg. Export weights with shape trading 430/kg throughout. First cross well fed clean bellied Hoggs 400p/kg throughout and lean Hoggs a sharp fall off at 375p/kg. Weight still best chased and seeing 48.5kg at 454p/kg whilst Robbie Tofield saw his run of 200 top at 454p/kg at 48.5kg and 46kg to 448p/kg. L C Threadgold & Son 48kg at 444p/kg with WG & SW Jones 48kg at 442p/kg. Lean weight 350p/kg mark. In the gross Export Hoggs to £208 at 45kg from Johnjoe Morris, Yelvertoft with Messrs Tustian 42kg at £206 with Messrs Tyacke, Johnjoe and Henry all beating £200 barrier. Heavies an still buoyant and £200 regularly passed. Top for the day a massive £269 at 74kg from E Glover who also sold to £256. H L Goodes last load of the year £252 at 75kg and L C Threadgold 65kg at £248. £230 then also beaten by Messrs Goode x 5 pens, C Lines, WH & IM Butcher, Hyde Lane Farms, WG & SW Jones and Messrs Glover x2 pens. Trade very much in the slide and we await the other side of Easter. Ramadan though nearing its end. The key to beating the contraction in trade is to ensure meat marketed. Today many sheep barely fit enough to kill.




