A yarding of just under 2200 with a mixed quality this week including some wonderful fed meat at the top end but a wealth of undercooked lambs forward today. An Sqq of 247p/kg a credit to the best fed lambs fitting Wholesalers and Butchers. A steady nationally with the end of the month and also the knowledge of French Port Worker Strikes due Wednesday to Friday restricting any Export loads for the week. Export weight lambs in general a hard sale throughout with lambs under 45kg finding a limited demand currently. Best end meat the easiest to sell topping at 304p/kg for 38.5kg Beltex from SH Gunn Ltd with W Bartlett Beltex 39kg to 295p/kg and G R Fountaine & Son 44.5kg to 294p/kg and R Richins 41.5kg 292p/kg. Heavies the order of the day returning an all in avg of £114. DS & LA Wadland saw 48kg Beltex to 288p/kg and BJ & IS Wain 50kg to 283p/kg. E Brain & Son 50kg and 48kg to 276p/kg. Export weights hovering all day either-side of £100 for run of the Mill Lambs under 43kg with better end seeing a massive premium. Top Export gross seeing £131 for 44kg from GR Fountaine & Son and £121 for 41.5kg from R Richins and R Heckford £119.50 for 44kg. Weight overall topped at £160.50 for 61kg and 58kg at £155.50 from BJ & IS Wain. £53 at 60kg from E Brain & Son and 61kg to £151 for Humphrey Livestock. Philly Batchelor 60kg to £148 for Cheviot.

Trade a hard sell at the moment. Currency falling should assist Export Sales but currently a slow demand throughout Europe and also a large supply of Lambs in the North of the UK seeming to hang the balance against price. Hopefully French Ports re-open soon!!

Home baking – Fruit Cake

Ingredients:

225g (8oz) S R Flour 1 tsp mixed spice ½ tsp ground cinnamon ½ tsp ground nutmeg 175g (6oz) butter 175g (6oz) soft brown sugar 1 tbsp black treacle 1 tsp each grated orange and lemon rind 4 eggs 550g (1 ½ lb) mixed dried fruit 100g (40z) chopped mixed peel 50g (2oz) glacé cherries 15ml milk

To finish: Brandy to feed

Method:

Pre-heat the oven to $150^{\circ}/300^{\circ}$ F/Gas 2. Grease and line an 8in (20cm) deep round cake tin with a double layer of greased greaseproof paper.

Sift flour with spice, cinnamon and nutmeg.

Cream butter with sugar, treacle and orange and lemon rind.

Beat in eggs, one at a time, and adding 1 tbsp of sifted dry ingredients with each other. Stir in mixed fruit, chopped peel, and cherries.

Fold in dry ingredients alternately with milk.

Transfer to prepared tin and smooth top with a knife. Bake for 4 – 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ hours or until a skewer comes out clean. Leave in tin for 15 minutes then turn out onto a wire cooling rack.

When cool, pierce the cake at intervals with a fine skewer and feed with a little brandy. Wrap the completely cold cake in a double layer of greaseproof paper and again in foil and store in a cool place for up to 3 months, feeding at intervals with more brandy.

Leave undecorated.
