A national slow in numbers and meat has thankfully led to an uplift in trade. A massive difference in trade between fed lambs and those barely better than stores. An SQQ of 248p/kg putting us well up the tree this week and miles ahead of any deadweight comparison. Top today up from Buckinghamshire in the form of LA & VS Evans selling 38kg to 318p/kg. The A14 continuing to provide a quick conduit for vendors from Norfolk seeing 45kg at 300p/kg and 310p/kg at 44kg for GEW Farming selling perfectly finishing Beltex lambs a full example of what the trade requires. Messrs Evans also 42.5kg at 298p/kg and Humphrey k45.5kg at 284p/kg. Weight remaining a well chased commodity despite the sharp fall on weight in the middle of last week. SLAM Farmings first draw of the Season saw 47kg Blue Texels to 281p/kg with BC Burton bringing out the quality sat 46.5kg & 47kg to 281p/kg. W G King up from Thame at 280p/kg and Parry Walters 50kg 280p/kg.

An all in avg today of £113 across the Board all included. Euro spec topping at £136.50 for 44kg and £135 for 45kg from GEW Farming. £129 for 45.5kg from Humphrey Livestock and £127.50 for 45kg from J T Mold. Overall a top today from R F Wilson at 61kg to £151 with JK Smith & Son £148.50 63.5kg Suffolks and P Edwards 60kg to £144. HJ Douglass 60kg to £143.50. Some positive demand today but Sales numbers still slow and a very small numbers. Vendors are encouraged to ensure lambs are finished fully with little value in lightweight poor lambs.

Top today strong Texels from J & N Fyfe at £215 with RFS Ltd selling to £211 and £172. Weighted Ewes then regularly selling £150 to £170. Suffolks to £163.50 and £150 from B Wilson others £149.50. Generally Suffolks trading £130 plus. Mules to £121 for Upton Mill Farms and £118 for Peter Amor with S Freeman £111. Mules mainly smaller examples today but meat generally £108 plus. Grazing Ewes a hard sell. This is almost certainly the year Vendors should consider feeding Ewes for a good return and to farm in line with demand.


