1800 lambs forward although more expected, but perhaps, held back by Sundays deluge. A huge increase in trade today as Supply dips under Demand for the first time resulting in a huge SQQ of 270p/kg. All buyers firing on all accounts albeit a grand show of quality about today with no real shape but plenty of meat on display throughout. Best end a massive premium and charging around the 300p/kg mark regularly. Export weights topping at 317p/kg at 43kg from F Hodgkin and R Webb a first time vendor selling 41kg to 312p/kg. Goats to 318 and 319p/kg for Jo Webster. Export weight lambs seeing quality regularly 290 - 300p/kg and basic export lambs 250 -270p/kg dependant on finish. Heavy lambs again the Butchers choice seeing the highest ppk of the day take 356p/kg at 56kg from DS & LE Wadland selling to Menai Meats Wales. V Phipps, back with pure quality to sell 48kg at 327p/kg whilst K Buckby sold Blue Texel at 48.5kg to 309p/kg. HL Goode & Son first real draw saw 54kg at 306p/kg. Todays all in avg an absolutely massive £125.50!!! On the deadweight that would require an all in carcass avg of 24kg!! Export lambs topping today at £140.50 for 45.5kg from R H Burman with D Wadland £138 at the same weight. F Hodgkin 43kg to £136.50 and Pear Tree Farming 45kg to £136 with Mark Lambert 44kg to £135. Weight pays and plenty on show today seeing a top of a massive £196 at 67kg from FJ Tombs & Son with Messrs Wadland 54kg at £192. Bailey & Moore saw 62kg Texels at £174 before Doody Livestock dropped it like its hot with 63kg at £173.50. LA &V Holtom & Son 71kg Suffolks to £170. Todays 121 Lambs selling over £150!!!

Trade simply flying especially when considering the cost of Lamb on the Menu. Trade though today a real flyer with all Abbatoir owners present and correct and needing numbers. A welcome return of the 'Feel Good Factor' to the Lamb Industry.

A nice yarding of Suckled Calves for this annual event. A year when the Stock have had a hard time and this was evident throughout. A tribute to our Vendors that Stock looked in such good fettle and indeed the number of those now taking heed and vaccinating for pneumonia. A benefit felt by many of the Buyers whom competed extra hard for 'safe bets'.

Trade must be described as ahead of expectations. Baby Bulls saw 7 month old Simmentals to £715 before strong for age 4 month old Simmental Steers from G Fell made £800 and £830. Messrs Alderman made his annual appearance to sell vaccinated Blonde Steers 8 months of age to £920 for a trio and others £915 with Sisters £855. Lim x from D & GM Wright sold Steers to £850 and £820 and Heifers £740. A real run of Limousin Steers from JD Stephens saw a pen of 6 Steers at 9 - 7 months at £915 with others at £900 and £850. Sisters to £775. A real following from C & A Morley saw Chaarolais Steers 7-8 months at £1170 with a pen of 6 at £1035 and 4 at £1015. Sisters £980 and £800. A super run from the Friswell family not just as strong as normal but every bit as well bred. Topping out at £1065 for 8 month old Steers others, £1055, £1030,£1020,£990,£985 & and plenty £950. Sisters perhaps stronger than the Heifers saw £1040,£1030,£1010,£1000,£995 and £990. Roland Sherratt next in with the much loved Charolais £1030 at 8 months and £970 with 9 months to £900. Messrs Snoxall saw Steers at 9 months with plenty of shape and bone at £995 with sisters to £880. A grand run from JK Smith & Sons holding the same comments as most of the yard being Cattle weaned earlier than expected due to the weather. The return customers for this run though very welcome of the Pneumonia vaccination. Starting with Simmental Steers 10 months of at at £1045 & £1010 and older sorts £1110 others saw £990. 
